DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Remove cap. Hold can upright 6 to 8 inches from pet. Point nozzle towards pet and press button. Move can for thorough even coverage of coat (until tips of hair are moist). Ruffle long hair for spray to reach pet's skin. Don't spray in eyes. Repeat once a week if necessary. Use on bedding and immediate area as needed. Spray into cracks and crevices where ticks may be found indoors.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in cool, dry place. To dispose of empty container replace cap and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Do not spray into eyes. Avoid breathing of spray and avoid contact with human skin. Wash hands after using. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Contains a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine sulfate is antidotal. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of treatment area. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Do not use on puppies less than 8 weeks old.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT
IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with plenty of soap and water.
IF IN EYES: Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL AND CHEMICAL HAZARDS

EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE. Do not use or store near fire, sparks, or heated surfaces. Turn off pilot lights in gas appliances and unplug or turn off electrical equipment in the use area. After auring out phase is completed, reight pilot lights and reconnect electrical current. Do not smoke in the use area. Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Incineration of container may cause explosion.
