### Sergeant's EAR MITE PREPARATION

**IMPORTANT CONSUMER INFORMATION**  
**PURPOSE:** Sergeant's Ear Mite Preparation is specially formulated to kill mites which cause itching, scratching and odor in cat's ears.  
**DIRECTIONS:** It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product inconsistent with its labeling. Saturate cotton swab with preparation and clean the ear. Apply 4 or 5 drops in the ear canal every three or four days for three or more applications as needed. If no improvement is shown after two weeks of treatment, consult a veterinarian. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.  
**CAUTION:** Harmful if swallowed. Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid contamination of feed and food-stuffs. Keep out of reach of children.  
**ANTIDOTE:** External—In case of spillage on the skin, wash promptly with soap and water. Internal—Induce vomiting by administering 1 tablespoon of mustard in a tumbler of water. Call a physician.  
**INGREDIENTS:** Active Ingredients Methylene Chloride, 3.70%; Rotenone, 0.06%; Other Cube Extractives, 0.11%; Vegetable Oil, 96.13%.

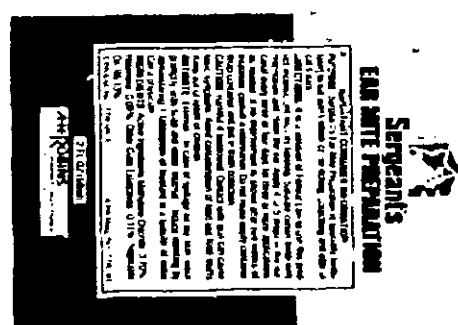

Your Application Dated December 17, 1982

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable. A stamped copy is enclosed for your records.

Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. Immediately under "Important Consumer Information" revise the Precautionary Statements into the following format:

Precautionary Statements  
Hazards to Humans  
Caution

Harmful if swallowed. Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid contamination of feed and food stuffs. Do not use on humans.

- b. Revise "Directions" to "Directions for Use."
- c. Separate the Storage and Disposal statement from the Directions for Use and reformat according to the following example:

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and put in trash collection.

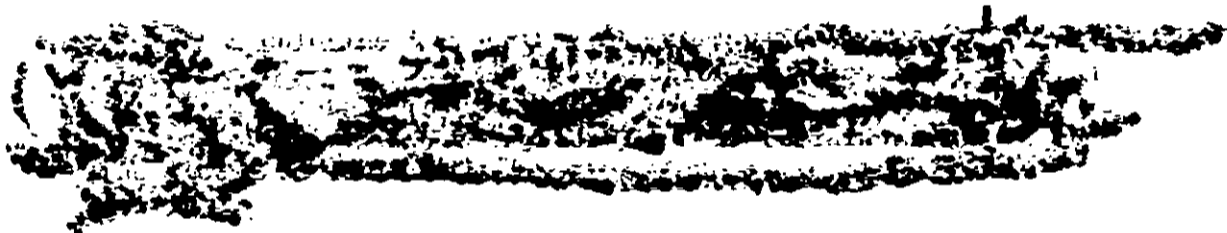

4. Your antidote statement is noted with mustard being advocated as an emetic. The Agency's toxicologist does not recommend that mustard be used for this purpose. The following revision is recommended to replace your antidote statement:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.



We are still attempting to determine if this product should be regulated by FDA/EPA or by EPA. You will be notified when this determination is made.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA Sec. 6(c). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
