 Storage: Store in cool, dry place. Do not store near water, food or feed. Dispose of unused product. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and flush toilet.

Sergeant's Ear Mite Preparation is specifically formulated to kill mites which cause itching, scratching and poor health in cats.

Use only in cats. It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Saturate cotton swab with preparation and clean the ear. Apply 4 or 5 drops in the ear canal every three or four days for three or more applications as needed. If no improvement is shown after two weeks of treatment, consult a veterinarian.

DO NOT USE IN DOGS. Store in cool, dry place. Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Rinse empty container and put in wash container.

CAUTION

Avoid contact with skin. Contact with skin can cause toxic symptoms. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs. Do not use on humans.
