

Sergeant's EAR MITE PREPARATION

IMPORTANT CONSUMER INFORMATION

Use of E. Sergeant's Ear Rinse® Precautionary Statement: It is illegal to use this product where it is not registered, except as authorized by law.

EPA Reg. No. 770-30. This is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Saturate cotton swab with preparation and clean the ear. Apply 4-5 drops in the ear canal every three (3) to four days for three (3) months as needed. If improvement is shown after 30 days of treatment, discontinue.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: Store in cool, dry place. Do not contaminate water used for storage or disposal. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap empty container and put in trash bag.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS: HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Contact with skin can cause local symptoms. Avoid contamination of food and cosmetics. Do not use on children if swallowed. Do not apply drops of ears and induce warming by touching the back of their ear with finger. Do not induce warming or great anything as means to an infant's person. 
