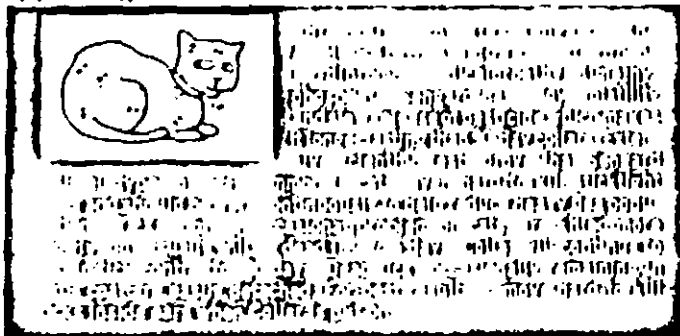


Sergeant's SENTRY IV CAT COLLAR

Sergeant's SENTRY IV FLEA & TICK COLLAR FOR CATS

DIRECTIONS: Buckle Collar securely but not tightly around cat's neck. COLLAR SHOULD BE WORN LOOSELY. Cut off and dispose of any excess length. Collar will start killing fleas on cat immediately. New fleas temporarily appearing will be killed during four months Collar is worn. When bathing cat, remove Collar, until cat is dry. Use the Sentry IV Cat Collar in addition to regular collar. Replace when effectiveness diminishes.



ACTIVE INGREDIENT
Maled (1,2-dibromo-2,2-dichloroethyl dimethyl phosphate) 10%

INERT INGREDIENTS 90%

CAUTION: Do not open inner envelope until ready to use. Collar is intended for use only as an insecticide generator and is not to be taken internally by man or animals. Even with the Sentry IV Collar, some cats may be sensitive and may develop neck irritation and loss of hair under the Collar if it is worn too tightly. When Collar is first worn, observe neck area for irritation every few days. Remove Collar if there is evidence of irritation and permit area to heal. Do not use on sick or convalescing cats. Do not use any other pesticide while Collar is worn. Do not use on kittens under 3 months of age.

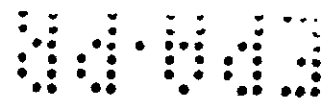
