IMPORTANT CONSUMER INFORMATION

PURPOSE: This collar kills fleas and aids in the control of ticks on cats and new ones picked up from environment. Collar is a new, double layer sustained-release system which combines the insecticidal actions of vapor and powder, working two ways to provide fast control and long-lasting head-to-tail protection. Thus, Collar has the effect of simultaneous usage of a spray and powder in aiding in the control of fleas and ticks. Note: Ticks are only an occasional problem on cats. Wetting will not impair Collar's effectiveness. It is not necessary to remove Collar if cat is out in the rain. Use continuously for most effective control.

DIRECTIONS: Place Collar around cat's neck, adjust for fit, and buckle in place. The Collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the cat and to permit the Collar to move about the neck. Leave 2 or 3 inches for extra adjustment. Cut off and dispose of excess length. Wash hands after installing Collar on cat. Under normal conditions, replace Collar every 5 months. With severe infestations, replace when effectiveness diminishes.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Do not open until ready to use. Dust will form on collar during storage. Do not get dust in mouth or eyes. Harmful if swallowed. If in eyes, will cause temporary capillary constriction. In case of contact, flush eyes with water. The dust released by this collar is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Collar is intended for external use only on cats, not to be taken internally. Some animals may become irritated by any Collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs, loosen Collar. If irritation continues, remove Collar and consult your veterinarian. Do not use on kittens under 3 months of age.
