If irritation continues, remove collar and consult your veterinarian. Do not use on cats.

PURPOSE: This collar kills fleas and aids in the control of ticks on dogs and new ones picked up from environment. Collar contains a new, sustained release system which combines the insecticidal actions of vapor and powder, working two ways to provide fast control and long lasting head-to-tail protection. Thus, Collar has the effect of simultaneous usage of a spray and powder in aiding in the control of fleas and ticks, including Rocky Mountain Wood Tick, carrier of Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever. Wetting will not impair Collar's effectiveness. It is not necessary to remove Collar if dog goes swimming or is out in the rain. Use continuously for most effective control.

DIRECTIONS: Place Collar around dog's neck, adjust for fit, and buckle in place. The Collar must be worn loosely to allow for growth of the dog and to permit the Collar to move about the neck. Generally, a properly fitted Collar is one that, when loosened, will snugly slide over dog's head. Leave 2 or 3 inches for extra adjustment. Cut off and dispose of excess length. Wash hands after installing Collar on dog. Under normal conditions, replace Collar every 3 months. With severe infestations, replace when effectiveness diminishes.

Do not open until ready to use. Collar is intended as an insecticide generator. Some animals may become irritated by any Collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs, loosen Collar. If irritation continues, remove Collar and consult your veterinarian. Do not use on cats.
