PURPOSE: This collar KILLS FLEAS and TICKS for up to three months. The Sergeant's Flea and Tick Collar contains effective insecticides which provide both head-to-tail protection. This collar KILLS fleas and ticks, including ticks that carry Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever. To remove collar if the dog goes swimming, moisture will not impair this collar's effectiveness. This is the most effective control.

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal Law to use in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Place collar around neck, adjust for fit, and buckle in place. The collar should be removed for growth of the dog and to permit the collar to slide over your dog's head. Leave two or three inches of collar. Cut off and dispose of excess length. Dispose of empty pouch in trash. Wrap in plastic.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS - HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Keep out of reach of children. Do not use on cats. Wash hands with soap and water after handling. Do not use on convalescing, pregnant or nursing dogs. Do not use on dogs less than 6 months of age. This collar contains a cholinesterase inhibitor (which may include atropine) which may cause diarrhea. Atropine is antidotal only if cholinesterase inhibition are present. Some animals may be sensitive to this collar if it is applied too tightly. If this occurs, remove collar and consult your veterinarian.
