Please qualify these statements, revising them to read, "for up to 6 months." d. The "Precautionary Statements" section should precede the "Directions for Use" section.

- e. Add the following wording to the precautionary statements:

Wash hands with soap and water after handling collar. Do not use other pesticides on dog while collar is worn. Do not use on sick or convalescing dogs. Do not use on puppies less than 5 weeks old.

- f. Revise the statements:

The dust released by this collar is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal.

In its place add the following statements:

Note to Physician: This product contains cholinesterase inhibitors. If symptoms of cholinesterase inhibition are present, atropine sulfate by injection is antidotal. 2-PAM is also antidotal and may be administered, but only in conjunction with atropine.

- g. Delete the wording "fast control." It is too vague. If you wish to make this claim you must stipulate how fast based upon supporting data, i.e., "Activity against fleas and ticks starts"

- h. Add the "Storage and Disposal" heading followed by the wording:

Store unopened collar in a cool dry place.
Do not reuse empty pouch or used collars.
Wrap pouch, excess collar, or used collar in newspaper and discard in trash.

- i. Please add a street address or P.O. Box along with the company name and city/State.
- j. Revise the end of the statement ". . . collar may be replaced more often" to read ". . . collar may be replaced more often but not sooner than 60 days."
- k. Italicize or capitalize the statement "Do Not Use on Cats."

3. The storage and stability study that was submitted raises a question about the difference in the (0.4%) Sendran. Please explain this variation.

4. The 6-month label claim is acceptable, but is conditional on the submission of the study entitled "Evaluation of Efficacy of A.H. Robins Experimental Flea Collars for Control of Fleas and Ticks on Dogs" dated November 13, 1986. This study should be submitted within 3 months from the date of this Notice of Registration.

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.
