This product is conditionally registered in accordance with FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(A) provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Add the phrase "EPA Registration No. 778-89" to your label before you release the product for shipment.
3. You must either submit the EPA Accession Numbers for the analytical methods and storage stability data, or submit the storage stability data. If you decide to submit the storage stability data, you must submit the results of analyses for the active ingredients from three production batches of your product. Test the product at the beginning when freshly prepared, and at monthly intervals for a period of 1 year under storage conditions similar to those to which the product will be exposed during marketing and distribution in channels of trade, and during use. You cannot reference storage stability data for a concentrate or intermediate that you use as a source of the active ingredient contained in your product.

On an interim basis the Agency will accept the results of an accelerated storage stability study conducted with your product. Submit the results from three batches maintained at 50 °C and analyzed at the

beginning, and at 30 and 60 days. The data must be submitted within one (1) year from the date of this Registration Notice.

4. We have no objection to the additional brand name "Sergeant's Tick Killer (with Permethrin)."

5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Shake well before using. Always hold the animal from a distance of 8 to 10 feet. Move the dispenser rapidly. Do not spray the animal's face. Make sure that the rest of the animal's body, including legs and under the body. While spraying, the animal will penetrate to the skin. Repeat as necessary. For dogs, 1/2 ounce per pound of body weight for thin or short-haired dogs; 1/4 ounce per pound of body weight for heavy dogs. For cats, 1/4 ounce per pound of body weight for heavy cats.
