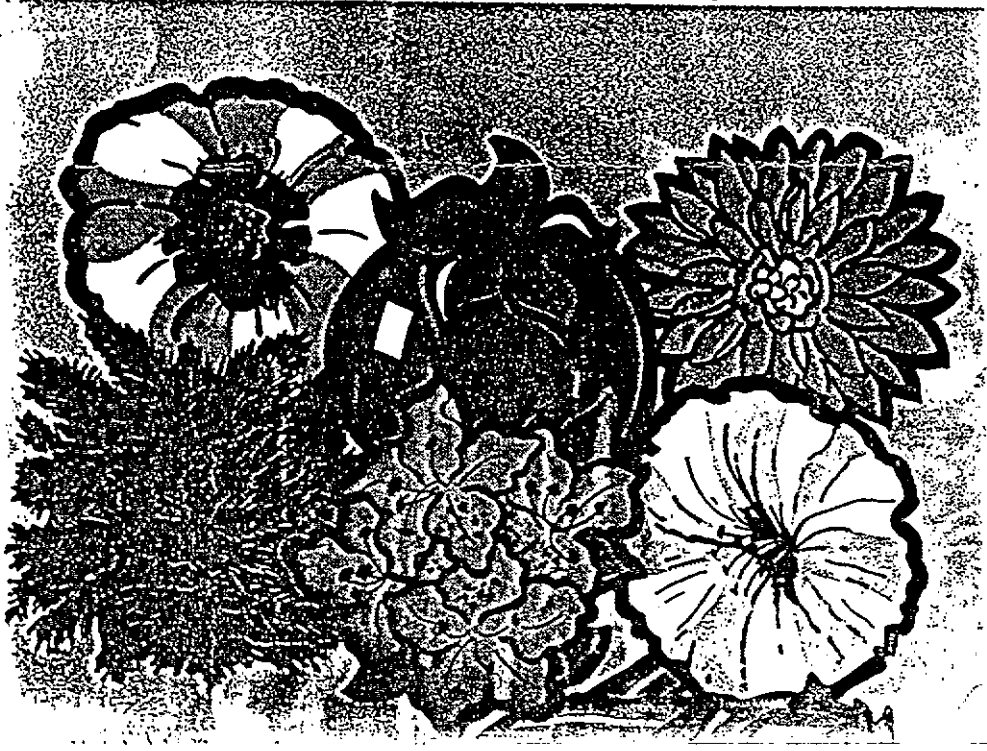

### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If swallowed — Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. Get medical attention immediately.

If inhaled — Remove victim to fresh air and apply respiration if indicated.

If on skin — Wash promptly with soap and water. Rinse thoroughly.

If in eyes — Rinse eyes for at least 15 minutes with water and call a physician immediately.

To control Leafhoppers, Thrips, and Plant Lice (Aphids) on Roses, Azaleas, Carnations, Chrysanthemums, Gladiolus, Peonies, Zinnias and Ornamental Turf Grasses.

Make application after first sprinkling area to be treated with water or when flowers or grass are damp after rainfall or dew has settled. Apply F&B Tobacco Dust thoroughly to both sides of moistened leaf surfaces sufficiently so as to insure contact of the dust with the bodies of insects. Apply 1 lb. to approximately 50 square feet of area to be treated. Repeat application at 7 to 10 day intervals.
