Purpose The purpose of this submission is to determine if your First Aid statements are acceptable according to current requirements.

Review of acute toxicity data In order to determine if your First Aid text is acceptable, which is governed by PR Notice 2001-1, we reviewed the values for your acute toxicity data:

This product also may be used to repel cottontail rabbits (*Sylvilagus Floridanus*) from entering, feeding in, or defecating within treated areas associated with flower gardens, ornamental plants, trees, and shrubs.

DO NOT USE THIS PRODUCT IN VEGETABLE GARDENS NOR ON FOOD CROPS. MAY BE USED AROUND THE PERIMETER OF VEGETABLE GARDENS. DO NOT ALLOW THE PRODUCT TO WIND DRIFT TO NEARBY FOOD CROPS.

Application Directions: Before treatment, try to remove all traces of animal droppings and urine from the areas to be protected. Animals are attracted by the odors of these deposits. If the odors are effectively removed, regular use of F&B Rabbit & Dog Chaser around ornamental and shrubs should discourage new defecations by dogs and visitations by rabbits.

Apply product in 2 or more inch-wide bands around the plants or the areas to be protected. Be careful not to apply product directly to foliage or stems. Repeat treatment as needed. More frequent applications will be needed if heavy rains, heavy snowfalls, hot weather, or high winds occur. The material in this package will produce a band of product 1 inch wide and 85 feet long.
