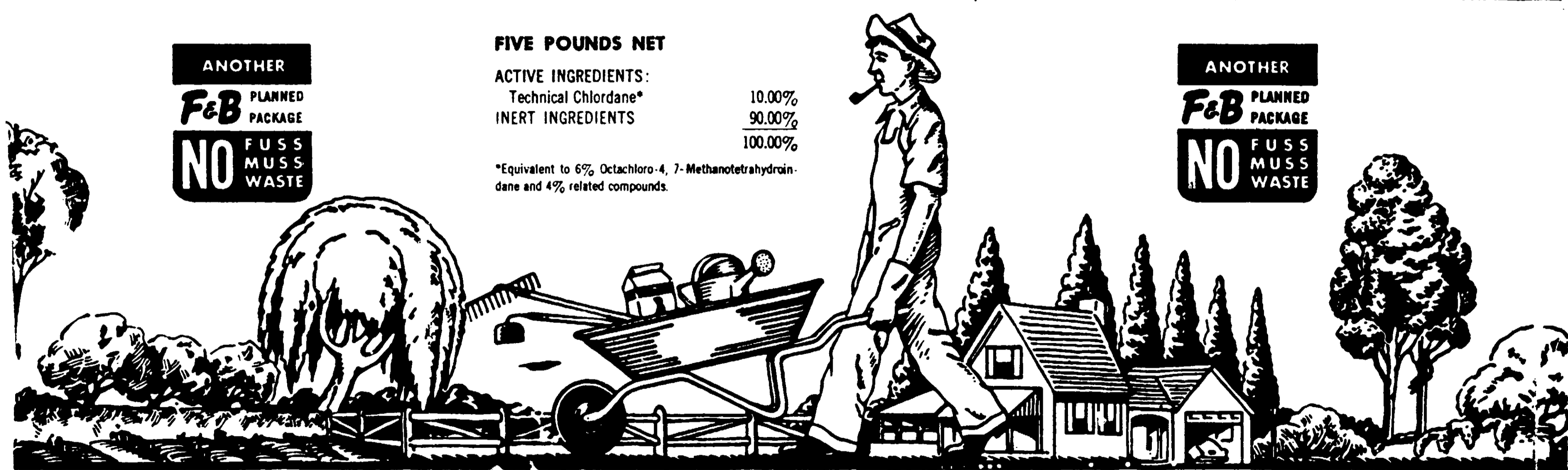

Chlordane is toxic and may be absorbed through the skin in dry form or from solutions. Avoid inhaling dust and mists from sprays or getting them in the eyes. Use respirator and goggles if necessary for protection. Avoid unnecessary skin contact. Keep clothing free from residues. Avoid contamination of feeds and foodstuffs. Do not use on dairy animals, or in or around dairy buildings, or on animals being finished for slaughter. Toxic to fish, birds and mammals. Do not contaminate fish ponds. Birds feeding on treated areas may be harmed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

CRABGRASS SEEDLINGS: MUST BE APPLIED before crabgrass seed germinates - in most areas should be applied before April 1st. WATER IN WELL down onto the soil surface. A temporary browning sometimes occurs.

- 15 lbs. per 1000 sq. ft. lawn area — 11¼ lbs. per 750 sq. ft. lawn area
- 7½ lbs. per 500 sq. ft. lawn area — 3¾ lbs. per 250 sq. ft. lawn area
- 1½ lbs. per 100 sq. ft. lawn area

FOR GARDEN SOIL

To control wireworms, white grubs, Japanese beetle grubs, root maggots on radishes. Work into top 2 or 3 inches of soil when preparing seed beds. 1 pound treats 400 square feet.

FOR LAWNS

To control cutworms, earwigs, mole crickets, sow lightly at the rate of 1 pound to 1000 to 1500 square feet of area. For white grubs, Japanese Beetle grubs and sod webworm (lawn-moth) apply liberally at the rate of 1 pound to 500 to 600 square feet. Water well with hose to get material into nests and living places.

CAUTION: Keep children and pets off treated lawn until insecticide has been washed into the soil.

FOR FOLIAGE DUST

To control grasshoppers, thrips and plant bugs on flowers, shrubs, and other ornamentals dust directly on the plant and insect. Repeat as necessary to prevent damage.

IN THE GARDEN

To control cutworms, earwigs, mole crickets, sow bugs, millipedes, slugs, snails and leaf cutting ants on flowers, shrubs and other ornamentals, dust liberally on the ground, around the plants. Remains effective at least 10 days. Re-Treat as necessary. 1 pound treats 400-600 square feet.
