RECOMMENDATIONS

INSECT CONTROL ON TURF (Golf Courses, Athletic Fields, Large Estate Nurseries, Cemeteries and ParksT, NURSERY AND GREENHOUSE SOILS:

For the control of Ants, Armyworms, Chiggers, Chinchbugs, Crickets, Grasshoppers, Rose Chafers, Spiders and Ticks — apply uniformly at the rate of 100 lbs. per acre (2½ lbs. per 1000 sq. ft.) using a lawn fertilizer spreader. Treatment should be made in the spring or when insects are observed to be troublesome. Apply before rain or sprinkling. Do not treat when soil is wet.

For the control of Sod Webworms, Japanese Beetle Larvae, White Grubs and Wireworms -- apply at the rate of 100 lbs. per acre (2½ lbs. per 1000-sq. ft) using a lawn fertilizer spreader. Apply just before a rain or use irrigation or sprinklers to wash the material into the top few inches of soil or into established turf. Do not treat when soil is wet.

For the control of Earwigs apply at the rates listed above to infested outside areas ---- especially along fences, walks and buildings.

For the control of Box Elder Bugs --- make applications at the rate of 100 lbs, per acre $(2\frac{1}{2})$ lbs, per 1000 sq. ft.) to the ground where the insects crawl. Water into the established turf.

CAUTION: Do not permit children or pets to go on treated lawn until the insecticide has been washed off the grass into the soil by drenching or sprinkling with water and grass has completely dried. Do not reuse bug. Destroy by burning. Stay away from smoke Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing of dust. Avoid contact with skin. Wash with soap and water after exposure. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs.

Toxic to Fish & Wildlife. Keep out of lakes, streems, ponds. Don't apply where runoff can occur. Don't contaminate water by cleaning equipment or waste disposal. Birds feeding in treated areas may be killed.



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
