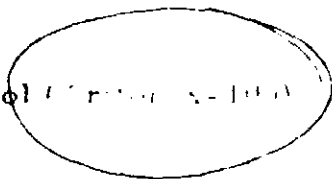

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: In most states it is obligatory to use a disinfectant and germicide such as our Sanitizer. This product is used in the final rinse in the washing operation. A very good disinfectant and germicide. Should be used only with Fect or Lime Clean as the detergents. May be used with other detergents if there is a three-tank operation.

Tank 1.. Fect or Lime Clean Tank 2.. Rinse Water Tank 3.. Sanitizer

1. Scrape and pre-wash utensils and glasses whenever possible.
2. Wash with Fect or Lime Clean (compatible detergents with this disinfectant solution).
3. Rinse with clean water.
4. Sanitize in a solution of 2 ounces to 4 gallons of water (390 PPM). Immerse all utensils for at least two minutes or for contact time specified by governing code.
5. Place sanitized utensils on a rack or drainboard to air dry.

FOR GENERAL DISINFECTION: Floors, walls, furniture, etc. use 2 oz. SANITIZER to 4 gal. of water (390 PPM) -hot or cold after cleaning.

FOR DAIRY INDUSTRIES, FOOD HANDLING PLANTS, ETC.: 2 oz. SANITIZER to 4 gallons of water as a final rinse.
