## "FABRIC SOFTENER CONCENTRATE"

Fabric treated as directed will develop residual bacteriostatic activity and residual self-sanitizing activity against Gram positive (*S. aureus*) and Gram negative (*E. coli*) organisms under conditions of high relative humidity or wet contamination. USE DIRECTIONS: Use 5 ounces per 100 pounds of laundry in RINSE CYCLE.

n-Alkyl(60% $C_{14}$ , 30% $C_{16}$ , 5% $C_{12}$ , 5% $C_{18}$ )dimethyl benzyl ammonium chlorides . . . 3.3%

n-Alkyl(68% $C_{12}$ , 32% $C_{14}$ ) dimethyl ethylbenzyl ammonium chlorides . . . . . 3.3%

INERT INGREDIENTS: . . . . . 93.4%
