FABRIC SOFTENER

Residual Bacteriostat and Residual Self-Sanitizer under Conditions of High Humidity or Wet Contamination.

Fabric treated as directed will develop residual bacteriostatic activity and selfsanitizing activity against Gram positive (S. aureus) and Gram negative (E. coli) organisms, under conditions of high relative humidity or wet contamination.
