# GRACE-LEE FABRIC SOFTENER

Residual Bacteriostat and Residual Self-Sanitizer under Conditions of High Humidity or Wet Contamination.

Fabric treated as directed will develop residual bacteriostatic activity and self-sanitizing activity against Gram positive (*S. aureus*) and Gram negative (*E. coli*) organisms, under conditions of high relative humidity or wet contamination.

For Commercial and Institutional Laundries.

GRACE-LEE FABRIC SOFTENER inhibits the growth of ammonia producing organisms (*B. ammoniagenes*) which act on urine in the diapers to produce ammonia.

GRACE-LEE FABRIC SOFTENER softens clothes, thus eliminating chafing, "static clings" out of nylons and other synthetics. Improves ironing time.

USE DIRECTIONS, Use 2 ounces of GRACE-LEE FABRIC SOFTENER per 8 pounds of laundry in rinse cycle. Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and discard it.

**ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:**

n-Alkyl(60% $C_{14}$ , 30% $C_{16}$ , 5% $C_{12}$ , 5% $C_{18}$ )dimethyl benzyl ammonium chlorides 0.8%

n-Alkyl(68% $C_{12}$ , 32% $C_{14}$ )dimethyl ethylbenzyl ammonium chlorides 0.8%
