GRACE-LEE SANIFOR is a proven "one-step" cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer-deodorizer for hospitals, nursing homes, schools, institutions, restaurants, food processing establishments, and all sanitation concerned businesses.

DIRECTIONS: It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

DISINFECTION: Apply 1/2 ounce per gallon GRACE-LEE SANIFOR to walls, floors, and other hard (inanimate) non-porous surfaces, such as tables, chairs, countertops, tile, porcelain, sinks, and bedframes. For heavily soiled areas a preliminary cleaning is required. Apply with a cloth, mop, or mechanical spray device. When applied with a mechanical spray device, surface must be sprayed until thoroughly wetted. Treated surfaces must remain wet for 10 minutes. Fresh solution should be prepared daily or when use solution becomes visibly dirty.

GRACE-LEE SANIFOR is a proven "one-step" cleaner-disinfectant-sanitizer-deodorizer in the presence of moderate amounts of organic soil and 400 ppm hard water.

SANITIZATION: Meat and food processing equipment and utensils: Remove heavy soils by flushing, scraping, or mopping. Wash with 1 ounce per gallon of GRACE-LEE SANIFOR. Rinse with clean water and sanitize surfaces with 1 ounce GRACE-LEE SANIFOR per 5 gallons of water (25 ppm titratable iodine). Surface should remain in contact with solution for 1-2 minutes. Drain well and air dry. No potable water rinse is required.

Sanitizing glassware, dishes, and food serving equipment: Remove heavy soils by flushing, scraping, or mopping. Wash with a good cleaning solution. Rinse with clear water and sanitize with 1 ounce GRACE-LEE SANIFOR per 5 gallons of water (25 ppm titratable iodine). Surface should remain in contact with solution for 1-2 minutes. Drain well and air dry. No potable water rinse is required.

DANGER: KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN. Corrosive. Causes eye damage and skin irritation. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Wear goggles or face shield and rubber gloves when handling. Harmful or fatal if swallowed. Do not breathe spray mist. Avoid contamination of food.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

Do not reuse empty container.

Rinse empty container thoroughly with water and detergent and discard in trash collection.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. For eyes, call a physician. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If swallowed drink promptly a large quantity of milk, egg whites, gelatin solution; or if these are not available, drink large quantities of water. Avoid alcohol. Call a physician immediately.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage. Measures against circulatory shock, respiratory depression, and convulsion may be needed.
