

DIRECTIONS:

For best results, use MINT O SOL with a cloth or mop and apply to walls, floors and other hard surfaces.

Use at 2 ounces per gallon. MINT O SOL will be effective against Pseudomonas aeruginosa PRD-10 at this level. This has been substantiated by the AOAC Use Dilution Confirmation Test. At this level, MINT O SOL is fungicidal against pathogenic fungi and disinfects influenza A2 virus on environmental surfaces.

For heavy soil or organic matter, a precleaning step is recommended.

To clean, disinfect and deodorize bed pans, urinals and similar bedside utensils, flush and wash with a swab using a minimum of 2 ounces of MINT O SOL to a gallon of water.

To clean, disinfect and deodorize rubber mattress covers, spray with a solution using a minimum of 1 ounce MINT O SOL to a pint of water and wipe dry with a towel.
