



DIRECTIONS: After using the whirlpool drain the water to a level where the water intake is barely covered. Add 2 oz. of WHIRL CLEAN to each gallon of water remaining in the tub. Start the pump to circulate the water. Wash down the sides of the tub with a swab or sponge. Completely drain and rinse cleaned surface with fresh water.

This solution will kill *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Salmonella Typhosa* and *Trichophyton interdigitale* a causative agent of athlete's foot.
