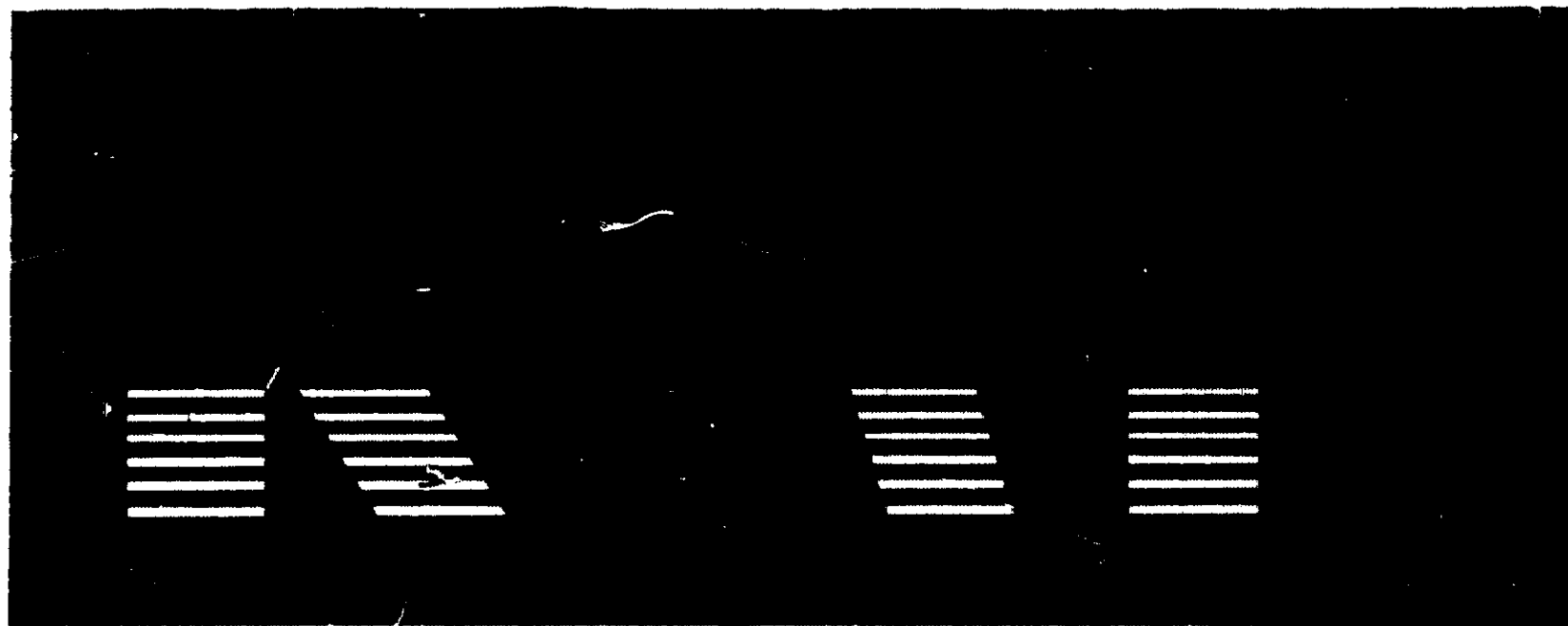

**FLIES, ROACHES, MOSQUITOES, BED BUGS, FLYING MOTHS, FLEAS,
CARPET BEETLES, WATER BUGS AND CERTAIN OTHER INSECTS.**

DIRECTIONS

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS, SPIDERS: Close all windows and doors. Spray RAP, directing spray up towards ceiling. The room should be filled with mist and remain closed for 10 to 20 minutes. Sweep up the dead or stupefied insects and destroy them. Repeat as often as necessary.

ROACHES, WATER BUGS, and SLIVER FISH: Spray RAP liberally around refrigerators, sinks, all cabinets, pantry shelves, into all cracks and crevices in molding and woodworks, pipe openings, in wall and floor, or wherever these insects are likely to hide. Spray should be so directed as to hit insects directly. Repeat as often as necessary.

FLYING MOTHS, CARPET BEETLES, and FLEAS: Take special precautions that floor cracks and openings below baseboards are thoroughly wetted with RAP. Wool, lint, and organic matter accumulating in these places serve as breeding materials for the insects. Chests in which woolens are to be stored should be thoroughly sprayed before being filled with clothes. Garments stored in closets should be removed before spraying closets. Closets should be sprayed liberally at least twice a month. Clothing to be stored should be cleaned, aired, hung loosely, and sprayed carefully with RAP from a distance of one to two feet before being hung in closet for storage; see that seams and folds are wetted with the spray.

CARPET BEETLES: Spray both top and underside of carpet, carpet seams, floorboards and baseboards.

FLEAS: To control, spray sleeping quarters of pets. Do NOT spray animal pets.

ANTS: Spray RAP so as to wet as many insects as possible, paying particular attention to nests or runways. Repeat treatment as often as necessary.

BED BUGS: Dismantle bed and spray with RAP, springs and mattresses, paying particular attention to cracks, crevices, tufts and seams of mattress, loose wall paper, loose molding and places where these insects may hide. Repeat spraying with RAP weekly since bed bugs are difficult to kill.
