DIRECTIONS

FLEAS—Wet animal thoroughly with water and while animal is still wet, apply ADCO PET SHAMPOO. Use about three tablespoonsful for medium or average sized dog. Carefully work ADCO PET SHAMPOO into hair until a pronounced lather is formed over entire body. Rinse the animal after shampoo treatment. Repeat treatment as often as necessary.

LICE—Apply in same manner as directed for fleas to kill motile or active stages of lice. Repeat in one week to kill young lice that may have hatched from eggs. Apply additional treatments as needed.

EAR MITES—Mites occur commonly in wax in the ears of rabbits and to some extent in the ears of other pets. Syringe the ears with warm water and apply a few drops of the undiluted ADCO PET SHAMPOO into the ears so that it can penetrate the remaining wax and surrounding tissues. Repeat treatment as needed.

TICKS—Apply a small quantity of undiluted ADCO PET SHAMPOO with dropper or piece of cotton directly on each individual AMERICAN dog tick or BROWN dog tick on dogs. Repeat application as necessary when animal acquires ticks.
