PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS:

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF INHALED move person to fresh air. If irritation or discomfort occurs, see a doctor.

IF ON SKIN wash thoroughly with soap and water. Launder contaminated clothing.

IF IN EYES wash eyes with plenty of fresh water. If irritation continues, see a doctor.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

FOR USE IN THE WHEEL (Final bath)

Original charge:

1. Determine accurately total gallons in system
2. Add 1/2 gallon (64 fluid ounces) MOTHINE per gallon.
3. Circulate 10 minutes before adding clothes.
4. Run normal cleaning cycle.
5. Extract lightly* - dry and finish.

Make up:

Add 1 cup (8 ounces) of MOTHINE for each 12 gallon system from any source - make up, recovery tumblers maintain 1/2% by volume MOTHINE

FOR USE IN DIP TANKS

Mix 1 pint (16 ounces) MOTHINE with each 25 gallons clothes, extract lightly* - dry and finish.

*For full mothproofing protection, extracted woolen

Synthetic system - 50 pounds

Petroleum system - 25 pounds

for each 100 pounds dry weight of clothes.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Pesticide, concentrate, use solution, or rinseate the label instructions must be disposed of according to local procedures.

CONTAINERS. Triple rinse (or equivalent) for reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a approved state or local procedures.

Seller guarantee shall be limited to the terms of the label. The buyer assumes any risk to persons or property from handling and accepts the product on these conditions.
