2. The misuse statement "It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling" must appear under the <u>Directions for Use</u> heading and preceding the use directions.

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

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

FOR USE IN THE WHEEL (final bath)

Original charge:

- 1. Determine accurately total gallons in system.
- 2. Add 1/2 gallon (64 fluid ounces) PRO-TEC II to the system for each 100 gallone.
- 3. Circulate 10 minutes before adding clothes.
- Run normal cleaning cycle.
 Extract lightly⁴ dry and finish.

Make up:

Add 1 cup (8 ounces) of PRO-TEC II for each 12 gallons of solvent added to the system from any source - make up, recovery tumbler, still, reclaimer, etc. to maintain 1/2% by volume PRO-TEC II.

FOR USE IN DIP TANKS

Mix 1 pint (16 ounces) PRO-TEC II with each 25 gallons of solvent. Saturate clothes, extract lightly⁶ - dry and finish.

*For full mothproofing protection, extracted woolens should contain at least:

Synthetic system - 50 pounds solvent Petroleum system - 25 pounds solvent for each 100 pounds dry weight of clothes.
