

**CAUTION:**

Do not remain in treated area and ventilate the area after treatment is completed. Remove Birds, Pets and Fish bowls from room before spraying.

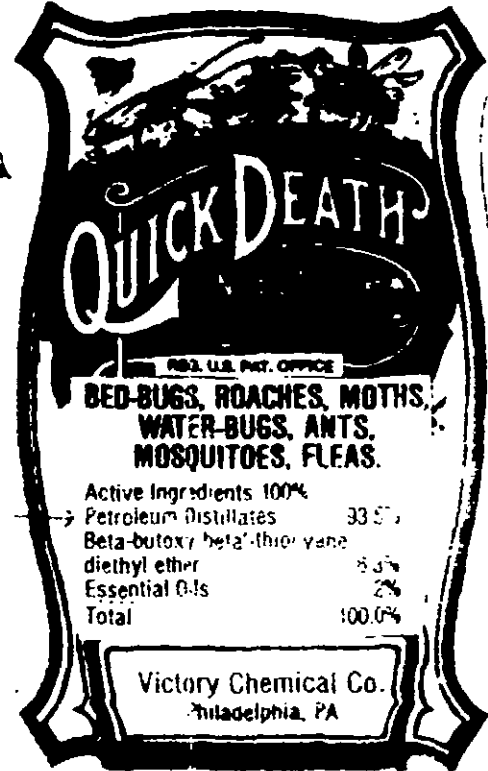
**If swallowed:** Call a physician immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USING QUICK DEATH

**Bed Bugs**—Spray QUICK DEATH liberally in all cracks, in Beds and Springs, on the ends of slats and Mattresses, around Picture Mouldings and Woodwork, wherever they may be concealed. Repeat application as necessary.

**Clothes Moths, Buffalo Moths, Carpet Beetles**—Spray QUICK DEATH liberally in Boxes, Trunks and closets, where clothes and furs are hung or packed, about once a month or as often as necessary. Take special precaution to see that cracks in floors and openings below the baseboards are thoroughly wetted with QUICK DEATH. Brush and clean clothing and articles and then spray them thoroughly, making sure to reach seams, folds and other hiding places. Repeat application monthly or after clothes are cleaned or washed.

**Controlling Ants in the House**—Spray QUICK DEATH on Ant trails and areas around door sills and window frames where Ants enter premises. Repeat application as necessary.

**Control of Fleas in the House**—Spray QUICK DEATH liberally on floors, baseboards, floor coverings, wall cracks and crevices. Never spray QUICK DEATH on animals. Repeat application as necessary.

**Water Bugs, Roaches, Silverfish**—Spray QUICK DEATH liberally in all cracks and crevices, this will bring them out, then spray QUICK DEATH on them. Spray frequently or as often as necessary, paying particular attention to nests, runways or wherever these insects are likely to hide.

**Flies, Mosquitoes, and Gnats**—Close windows and doors. Spray QUICK DEATH in the infested area and fill it with mist. The space should be left closed at least Ten minutes after treatment. It is frequently desirable to sweep up and destroy the fallen insects at the close of the Ten minute period.

The amendment referred to above submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, Rodenticide Act, as amend, is acceptable provided that you make the following changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. Add a referral statement on the front panel, such as, "See additional precautionary statements on side/back panel".
2. Delete the statements "Avoid skin contact and wash off thoroughly after exposure" and "Harmful if swallowed" under the heading "Caution" on the left panel since these statements already appear under Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.
3. Revise the statement, "Keep away from foodstuffs and open flames" to "Avoid contamination of food or foodstuffs" and place under Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.
4. Place the statement, "Avoid breathing of vapors or spray mist." under Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.
5. Incorporate the heading "Physical or Chemical Hazards" above your statement beginning, "Do not pour, spill or spray etc.". This section should appear under the general section "Precautionary Statements".
6. Since this product contains a high amount of petroleum distillate we suggest you revise the "If Swallowed"

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instruction to read as follows:

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Gastric lavage is indicated if material was taken internally. Do not induce vomiting. Vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia."

7. Immediately beneath the "Directions for Use" add the statement, "It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling."

There are no instructions indicating how the product is to be applied. Is this a ready-to-use product? Who is this product intended for?, homeowner?, commercial applicator? If this is for the homeowner it should be marketed as a ready-to-use product in a aerosol/pump spray or a spray trigger should accompany the product. If it is intended for commercial use then the product should state For Commercial/Industrial Use Only. Please explain.

Submit five copies of your revised printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Refer to the attached sample label for proper placement of precautionary statements.
