#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Causes substantial but temporary eye injury. Wear protective clothing, and goggles. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. #### FIRST AID

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

MIXING DIRECTIONS: Mix the required amount of MICROCOP® FUNGICIDE with a small amount of water to form a smooth, creamy paste. Next, add this paste to the required amount of water. Shake sprayer frequently while spraying to insure uniformity of solution.

NOTE: One ounce of MICROCOP® FUNGICIDE equals 2 1/3 tblsp. Lilly Miller Sta-stuk "m"™ extends the effective life of MICROCOP® FUNGICIDE by resisting the washing effects of rains and snows. Consult your State Agricultural Experiment Station or State Extension Service Authorities for additional information as the timing, number and rate of application will vary with local conditions.

### SPECIFIC DIRECTIONS - NOT FOR USE IN GREENHOUSES

FRUITS, NUTS AND VEGETABLES including

APPLES, PEARS - Anthracnose, Perennial Canker: Use 1 1/2 tblsp MICROCOP® FUNGICIDE plus 2 tsp superior type oil to 1 gal. of water. Apply as a wetting spray after fruit harvest.

PEACHES - Leaf Curl: Use 2 1/3 tblsp to 1 gal. of water. Apply in late fall or early winter before winter rains or snow. Repeat in late winter or early spring before buds break.

PEACHES, APRICOTS - Coryneum Blight: Use 1 1/2 tblsp to 1 gal. of water. Apply after harvest before fall rains.

FILBERT - Bacterial Blight (Oregon and Washington only): Use 2 1/3 tblsp to 1 gal. of water in late August or early September before the first heavy fall rains. In seasons of heavy rainfall during fall and winter, apply another spray when 3/4 of the leaves have dropped.

VEGETABLE SEEDLINGS - Damping Off: Use 1 1/2 tblsp to 1 gal. of water. Apply to soil surface in plant bed after emergence of seedlings. Repeat at 4 to 7 day intervals as needed.

CELERY, POTATOES, TOMATOES - Late Blight: Use 1 1/2 tblsp to 1 gal. of water. Apply at first sign of blight. Repeat at 4 to 5 day intervals until under control.

ORNAMENTAL WOODY SHRUBS AND VINES including

AZALEA - Galls (Flower, Leaf, Stem): Use 1 1/2 tblsp to 1 gal. of water. Apply to entire plant before buds break in the spring. Repeat 2 to 3 weeks later. Should any galled leaves appear, remove and burn. Anthracnose, Leaf Spots, Botrytis Blight: Use 1 1/2 tblsp to 1 gal. of water. Begin treatment in spring before disease appears and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals and after rains as needed.

CAMELLIA - Dieback; IVY - Bacterial Leaf Spot. LAUREL - Leaf Blights, Leaf Spots; LILAC - Leaf Spot; PYRACANTHA - Fire Blight, Scab; RHODODENDRON - Botrytis Blight, Bud and Twig Blight, Leaf Spots; ROSE Powdery Mildew: Use 1 1/2 tblsp to 1 gal. of water. Begin treatment in spring before disease appears and repeat at 7 to 10 day intervals and after rains as needed.

LILAC - Bacterial Blight: Use 1 1/2 tblsp to 1 gal. of water. Apply thoroughly in September and again before fall rains. Prune out and burn affected parts of the bush as they appear.

FLOWERING SHRUBS - Certain Leaf Spots (Cercospora, Septoria, Botrytis): Use 1 1/2 tblsp to 1 gal. of water. Spray at first appearance of small discolored areas on leaves. Repeat sprays as necessary.

ORNAMENTAL AND SHADE TREES including

ARBORVITAE, CYPRESS, JUNIPER - Berckman's Blight (Arborvitae only): Use 1 tblsp to 1 gal. of water. Spray twice in fall. First spray in late September or early October and second spray in early November. Coryneum Blight: Use 1 1/2 tblsp to 1 gal. of water. Apply in early spring and fall.

DOGWOOD - Use 1 1/2 tblsp to 1 gal. of water for the following: Anthracnose (NW only): Begin sprays at bud break, repeat 2 or 3 times at 10 day intervals; Leaf Spot, Leaf Curl: Apply as leaves uncurl in spring and repeat in 2 to 3 weeks.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

<u>PESTICIDE STORAGE</u>: Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Store this product in its original container and keep out of reach of children and domestic animals. <u>PESTICIDE DISPOSAL</u>: If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.
