LAWN WEED CONTROL

Spring (April-May) and Fall (Sept.-Oct.) applications for
Dandelions Plantain

Amount to use . . . Established Lawns

Use 2 tablespoons per gallon of water per 200 sq. ft. of lawn.

Wet solid patches of weeds thoroughly.

New Lawns

Use 1/2 tablespoon per gallon of water per 200 sq. ft. of lawn. Do not use until lawn is well established . . . after second or third cutting.

SPRAYING DIRECTIONS

1. Cover area uniformly with a coarse droplet spray, when there is little or no wind, so that the spray solution will not drift.
2. Apply with pressure sprayer, using a fan type spray nozzle, or with an ordinary sprinkling can with a small hole nozzle.
3. Diluted material, mixed in pail or can, may also be applied to weed patches using a broom or paint brush. Spot treat weed patches only with this method. This method is quick, very effective and economical. No spray drift.

APPLICATION

1. Fertilize lawn 7 to 10 days before treating.
2. Do not cut lawn 2 to 3 days before treating.
3. Soak lawn thoroughly with water night before treating.
4. Withhold water 2 to 3 days after treating.
5. Do not cut lawn for 3 to 4 days after treating.
6. Wet solid patches of weeds thoroughly.

SPOT APPLICATION

For Chickweed, False Dandelion and certain other hard-to-kill weeds

PLANTAIN

1. Use 4 tablespoons Miller's AMITOX, plus 2 tablespoons Miller's SPRA-OIL per gallon of water. Mix in pail or can.
2. Spot treat with broom or paint brush.
3. Wet patches of weeds thoroughly.

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. May cause skin irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of contact, flush with plenty of water; for eyes, get medical attention.

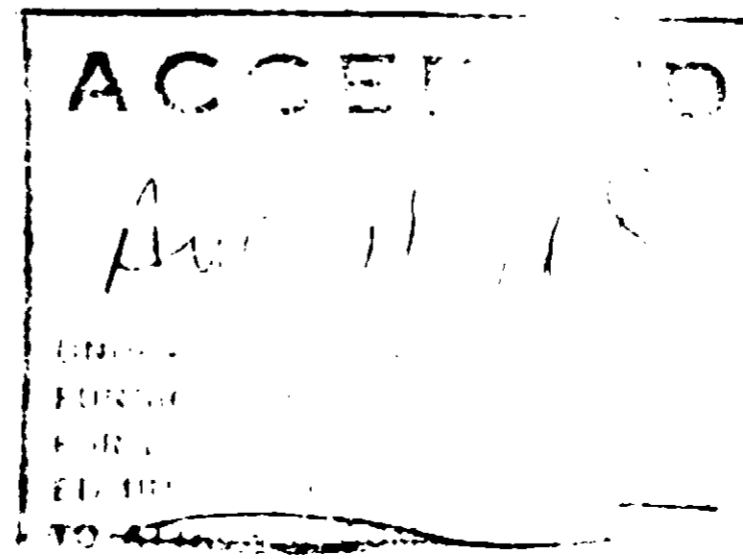
