

OUTSIDE OF HOMES

ANTS, EARWIGS, SPIDERS, BOX ELDER BUGS

1. Use 2 tablespoons per 1 gal. of water (1 pt. per 16 gal.)
2. Spray outside areas thoroughly. Apply around house, foundations, garbage containers, along runways, in cracks of cement walks and patios. Also spray Box Elder trees and other ornamentals where bugs congregate, using 2 teaspoons per 1 gal. of water.
3. Repeat as necessary.

TERMITES in Buildings

1. Use 1 pt. mixed with water to make 6 gallons of mixed spray.
2. **Homes with Basements or Crawl Spaces, New Construction.** Dig trench along inside and outside of foundations (5 to 18 inches deep, but not below footing, 18 to 12 in. wide). Use 2 gal. of mixed spray for each 5 linear feet, applying half the amount to the bottom of trench against foundation. Apply remainder of mixed spray proportionately at 6 inch intervals while back filling trench, making last application just below ground level and covering with a thin layer of soil. For trenches 18 to 30 inches deep but not below footing use 4 gal. of mixed spray for each 5 linear feet.
3. **Slab type Construction**—Apply 1 gal. mixed spray per 10 sq. ft. of soil surface as an over-all preconstruction treatment under slab for porches, entrance platforms and utility entrances.
4. Inspect area yearly to determine possible reinfestation and re-treat when necessary.

LAWNS

SOD WEBWORM (Lawn Moth), WHITE GRUBS, JAPANESE BEETLE LARVAE, ANTS, CUTWORMS, MOLE CRICKETS, ARMYWORMS

1. Use 2 tablespoons per 1 gal. of water (1 pt. per 16 gal.)
2. Apply evenly over the lawn at the rate of 1 gal. per 150 sq. ft.
3. To control **Nightcrawlers**, use 8 oz. in 10 to 15 gal. of water. Apply evenly over 1000 sq. ft. of lawn.
4. For best results apply in the evening when lawn is dry. After treatment, follow with moderate sprinkling (1/4 to 1/2 inch of water) to thoroughly wet the soil.
5. Keep children or pets off treated areas until insecticide is washed into soil and grass is thoroughly dry.

ORNAMENTAL GARDENS

STRAWBERRY ROOT WEEVIL (Brachyrhinus), CUTWORMS, BLACK VINE WEEVIL — Rhododendrons, Azaleas, Camellias, Primroses

1. Use 2 teaspoons per 1 gal. of water (1 pt. per 50 gal.)
2. **Established Plantings**—apply generously around the base of plants. Repeat as necessary.
3. **New Seed Beds**—apply at the rate of 1 gal. diluted material per 40 sq. ft. soil area and work thoroughly into top 4 to 6 inches of soil before planting.

THRIPS, ANTS, CERTAIN CATERpillARS, DIABROTICA BEETLES, FLEA BEETLES, LEAF MINERS, LEAFROLLERS, SOY-BUGS, LYGUS BUGS, STINK BUGS, EARWIGS, GRASSHOPPERS on Roses, Gladiolus, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Asters, Petunias, Carnations, Marigolds, Pansies, Zinnias

1. Use 2 teaspoons per 1 gal. of water
2. Spray plants thoroughly to cover both top and undersides of leaves, as well as soil around plants. Repeat as necessary.
