

GENERAL DIRECTIONS

DUSTING

- 1 Dust lightly on first appearance of insect or insect damage.
- 2 Repeat at 4 to 7-day intervals until under control.
- 3 Frequent light dustings are more effective than single heavy dustings.
- 4 Do not apply to food crops within one day of harvest.

ASPARAGUS — Asparagus Beetle.

BEANS, BEETS—Flea Beetles, Mexican Bean Beetles, Cucumber Beetles

CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, BROCCOLI, BRUSSELS SPROUTS, COLLARDS, KOHLRABI, KALE Flea Beetles, Cabbage Worms and Loopers, Vegetable Weevil.

CARROTS – Vegetable Weevil

LETTUCE - Cabbage Looper

POTATOES, EGGPLANTS, PEPPERS - Aphids, Colorado Potato Beetles, Flea Beetles.

TURNIPS, RUTABAGAS – Aphids, Flea Beetles, Variable Weevil

STRAWBERRIES — Spittle Bugs, Flea Beetles

FLOWERS such as: Roses, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Peonies
Sweet Peas, Phlox, Delphiniums, Marigolds, Zinnias, Flax
Beetles, Dabrotica, Aphids (Green and Rose).

CONCLUSIONS

Excluded: Low forehead or forehead through skin. Avoid protrusion of brow. Hair of crown with hair. Wavy crown including Wavy all. Banding
