


STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

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USE DIRECTIONS

DUSTING

1. Dust lightly on first appearance of insect or insect damage.
2. Repeat at 4 to 7 day intervals until under control.
3. Frequent light dustings are more effective than single heavy dustings.
4. Do not apply to food crops within one day of harvest.

ASPARAGUS - Asparagus Beetle.

BEANS, BEETS- Flea Beetles, Mexican Bean Beetles, Cucumber Beetles.

CABBAGE, CAULIFLOWER, BROCCOLI, BRUSSELS SPROUTS, COLLARDS, KOHLROBI, KALE - Flea Beetles, Cabbageworms and Cabbage Loopers, Vegetable Weevil.

CARROTS - Vegetable Weevil.

LETTUCE - Cabbage Looper

POTATOES, EGGPLANTS, PEPPERS - Aphids, Colorado Potato Beetles, Flea Beetles.

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
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
