

USE PRECAUTIONS

For foliage application the spray tank must be free of any sulfur residue before using this material. Do not combine sulfur sprays with this material on foliage during spring and summer months and do not follow a previous application of sulfur or apply sulfur following an application of this material until sufficient time has elapsed for safety (at least 30 days). If in doubt, spray a portion of one tree previously treated with sulfur using 2 1/2 Tbsp. oil to 1 gallon of water (1 quart of oil to 25 gallons of water). If sufficient time has not elapsed, burn will show in several days.

Do not use oil spray when temperatures are above 90 degrees F. When temperatures drop below 32 degrees F during night, do not spray tree and vine crops until daytime temperatures have warmed to a point above 35 degrees F and crops are free from moisture due to melting frost or heavy dews.

Do not use on foliage closer than 60 days after or 90 days before using CAPTAN or PHALTAN* products. Do not use in combination with SEVIN* [carbaryl]. Application to trees weakened by disease, drought, drying winds, or high nitrogen applications may result in oil injury.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

For best results, completely cover all twigs, branches and trunk with spray.

To control both insects and diseases, [EPA Reg. No. 801-415] and [EPA Reg. No. 802-73] can be used together. Spray [EPA Reg. No. 802-73] first and allow it to dry completely, usually 24 hours. Then spray [EPA Reg. No. 802-415].

HOW DO I USE THIS PRODUCT?

1. Shake container well.

2. Remove the child-resistant closure and save it for resealing the container when you are finished.

3. Insert the dip tube of the hose-end applicator into the bottle and seal the applicator head tightly to the bottle.

4. Connect spray nozzle to garden hose.

5. Turn on the water from the faucet.

6. When you are ready to spray, turn the knob on top so that it points to the MIX position on the spray head. (*Fig.1*)

7. The spray deflector on the front of the hose-end applicator can be rotated to give a stream or fan spray. (*Fig.* 2)

TO STOP SPRAYING:

1. When you are finished spraying or if you have to stop spraying at any time, turn the knob back to the OFF position. *(Fig. 3)*

2. Turn off the water from the faucet.

3. Turn the knob to H2O then OFF, to drain the water from the hose. (Fig. 4)

4. Unscrew spray nozzle from hose: Remove hose-end from container.

5. Reseal the container with the child-resistant closure. Rinse the hose-end applicator.
