The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

a. Add a 'Statement of Practical Treatment' directly after the CAUTION signal word, using the following instructions:

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash skin with soap and warm water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

b. Add a footnote to the Ingredients Statement indicating:

*Contains petroleum distillates.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

Do not apply this product to conduits, motor housings, or electrical switch boxes.

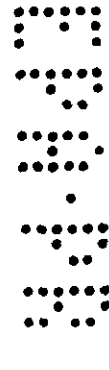

6 feet. Cracks, crevices and hard-to-reach locations can be reached without bending, crawling, or climbing. Spray infested areas until surface is wet, moving the spray stream rapidly to prevent excessive wetting of surfaces.

IMPORTANT - Hold Container Only in Upright Position to Spray. Shake well before each use. Direct spray away from face. Point spray away from people, plants, and pets. Do not allow children or pets on treated areas until spray is dry.

FOR USE INDOORS

Do not apply as a space spray.

To control ANTS, COCKROACHES, MILLEPEDES, SILVERFISH, SPIDERS, WATERBUGS, and to aid in the control of SAW-TOOTHED GRAIN BEETLE (exposed stage). Thoroughly spray into cracks and crevices, around baseboards, under sinks, refrigerators, cupboards, shelves, in and around garbage containers and similar areas where these pests may crawl or hide. For silverfish, also apply behind shelving, bookcases, and other storage places. Repeat applications as necessary. Applications of this product in food preparation areas are limited to crack and crevice treatments only.

FOR USE OUTDOORS

Do not spray on plant foliage.

ANTS*, BROWN DOG TICKS*, COCKROACHES, CLOVER MITES, CRICKETS, EARWIGS, FLEAS*, FLIES, HORNETS*, MILLIPEDES, MOSQUITOES, SCORPIONS, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS, WASPS*, WATERBUGS - Spray around window frames, door sills, foundations, patios, porches, garages or other places where insects may crawl before entering home. Repeat application as necessary.

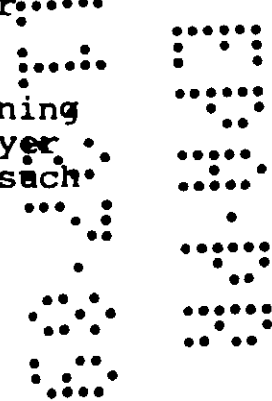
*For ants, spray directly on hills and runways. For brown dog ticks and fleas, spray to thoroughly wet cracks, crevices and areas where pets normally lie down. DO NOT SPRAY ON PETS. Be sure sprayed areas have dried thoroughly before allowing pets to return. For wasp and hornet nests, apply after dark when all insects have returned to the nest. Spray thoroughly to wet entrance and entire nest.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Keep this product out of reach of children and domestic animals. To discard, replace cap and securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
