DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For household use only.

One cup of GRASSHOPPER & EARWIG BAIT equals approximately 3 ounces.

GENERAL PRECAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift. Keep people and pets out of the area during application. Do not allow people or pets to enter the treated area until dusts have settled. In addition, if directions for use require watering-in, do not allow people (except those involved in the watering-in) or pets to enter the treated area until the watering-in is completed and the area has dried. Broadcast application to lawns is prohibited. Application is limited to spot treatments of 1000 square feet or less.

VEGETABLES AND FRUIT- To kill grasshoppers, earwigs, ants, cutworms, armyworms, crickets, darkling ground beetles, centipedes, Mormon crickets, mole crickets, millipedes and sowbugs. Broadcast lightly on soil surface around plants at the rate indicated for each crop. Do not allow bait to contact foliage or edible part of crops. Observe the number of days before harvest from last application as noted in parentheses following each crop.

Asparagus (1): Use 5 tsp per 25 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 7 days when applications are to spears; apply as often as every 3 days when applications are to ferns. Make no more than 3 applications prior to harvest and 2 additional applications to ferns only.

Snap Beans (fresh), Peas (fresh) (all 3): Use 4 tsp per 25 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 7 days. Make no more than 4 applications per year.

Beets (roots), Carrots, Radish, Parsnips, Rutabaga, Turnips (roots) (7): Use 5 tsp per 25 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 7 days. Make no more than 3 applications per year.

Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Kohlrabi (3): Use 5 tsp per 25 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 7 days. Make no more than 3 applications per year.

Chinese Cabbage, Kale, Collards (14): Use 5 tsp per 25 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 7 days. Make no more than 3 applications per year.

Sweet Corn (2): Use 5 tsp per 25 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 3 days. Make no more than 8 applications per year.

Cucumber, Melon, Squash (3): Use 3 tsp per 25 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 7 days. Make no more than 6 applications per year.

Lettuce (head and leaf), Endive, Celery, Dandelion, Parsley, Swiss Chard, Hanover Salad, Rhubarb, Beets (Tops), Turnip (Tops) (15): Use 5 tsp per 25 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 7 days. Make no more than 3 applications per year.

Potatoes (7): Use 5 tsp per 25 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 7 days. Make no more than 3 applications per year.

Strawberries (7): Use 5 tsp per 25 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 7 days. Make no more than 5 applications per year.

Tomatoes, Peppers, Eggplant (3): Use 5 tsp per 25 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 7 days. Make no more than 4 applications per year.

LAWNS, FLOWERS, SHRUBS AND OTHER ORNAMENTALS

To control grasshoppers, earwigs, ants, cutworms, armyworms, crickets, darkling ground beetles, centipedes, Mormon crickets, mole crickets, millipedes and sowbugs. Cutworms and earwigs are active at night and spend the daytime just below the soil surface, in cracks and crevices or underneath leaf litter and rocks. Sowbugs prefer damp areas.

For protection of ornamental plants: Apply GRASSHOPPER & EARWIG BAIT around ornamentals in shady, protected areas, at the base of walls and fences, and in 2 to 4 inch wide bands along the edge of walkways and patios. Use 2 to 4 oz. of GRASSHOPPER & EARWIG BAIT per 250 sq. ft. For best results be sure that area to be treated is damp.

For use on lawns: Mow lawn, remove clippings and thoroughly water. Apply GRASSHOPPER & EARWIG BAIT at the rate of 4 to 8 oz. per 500 sq. ft.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
