


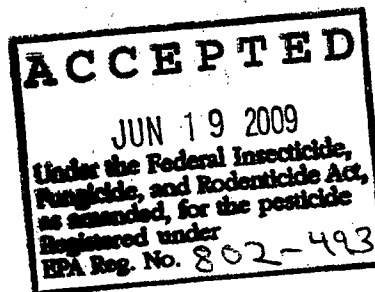

FIRST AID

Have product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment. You may also contact [1-800-265-0761] [the National Pesticide Information Center at 1-800-858-7378] for emergency medical treatment information.

If swallowed: Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Contains N-methyl carbamate insecticide which is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Specific antidote consists of atropine. Narcotics and other sedatives should not be used. Drugs like 2-PAM (pyridine-2-aldoxime methiodide) are NOT recommended.

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Harmful if absorbed through skin. Avoid contact with eyes, skin or clothing. Wear long sleeved shirt and long pants, shoes, socks and chemical resistant gloves (such as or made out of any waterproof material, selection Category A).

USER SAFETY RECOMMENDATIONS:

User should wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Remove clothing immediately if pesticide gets inside; then wash thoroughly and put on clean clothing. Remove clothing immediately after handling this product. Wash the outside of gloves before removing. As soon as possible, wash thoroughly and change into clean clothing.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

This product is extremely toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water or allow to drift to water. To protect the environment, do not allow pesticide to enter or run off into storm drains, drainage ditches, gutters or surface waters. Applying this product in calm weather when rain is not predicted for the next 24 hours will help to ensure that wind or rain does not blow or wash pesticide off the treatment area. Sweeping any product that lands on a driveway, sidewalk or street back onto the treated area of the lawn or garden will help to prevent runoff to water bodies or drainage systems.

GRASSHOPPER & EARWIG BAIT may be applied in vegetable gardens, on lawns, and in ornamental plantings. It kills grasshoppers, earwigs, ants, cutworms, armyworms, crickets, darkling ground beetles, centipedes, Mormon crickets, mole crickets, millipedes and sowbugs.

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DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. Intended for household use only.

Do not apply this product in a way that will contact any person or pet, either directly or through drift. Keep people and pets out of the area during application. Do not enter or allow others to enter the treated area until dusts have settled. Watering-in is required after application to lawns. Do not enter or allow others to enter treated lawns or turf (except those persons involved in the application and watering) until the watering in is complete and until surface is dry after the watering-in. Only apply this product from the ready-to-dispense container by sprinkling directly on soil in the area to be treated. Do not apply by hand, spoon or belly grinder.

LISTED VEGETABLES AND FRUIT

To kill grasshoppers, earwigs, ants*, cutworms, armyworms, crickets, darkling ground beetles, centipedes*, Mormon crickets, mole crickets, millipedes and sowbugs. Sprinkle lightly on soil surface around plants. Do not exceed ¼ pound per 250 sq. ft. Reapply as often as every 7 days, up to 4 applications per year. Do not allow bait to contact foliage or edible part of crops. Observe the number of days before harvest from last application as noted in parentheses following each crop group.

- Asparagus (1)
- Beets (roots), Carrots, Radish, Parsnips, Rutabaga, Turnips (roots) (7)
- Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Kohlrabi (3)
- Chinese Cabbage, Kale, Collards (14)
- Cucumber, Melon, Squash (3)
- Potatoes (7)
- Tomatoes, Peppers, Eggplant (3)

LAWNS, FLOWERS, SHRUBS AND OTHER ORNAMENTALS

To kill grasshoppers, earwigs, ants*, cutworms, armyworms, crickets, darkling ground beetles, centipedes*, Mormon crickets, mole crickets, millipedes and sowbugs. Cutworms and earwigs are active at night and spend the daytime just below the soil surface, in cracks and crevices or underneath leaf litter and rocks. Sowbugs prefer damp areas.

*Must be directly contacted at the time of application to be effective.

For ornamental plants: Apply GRASSHOPPER & EARWIG BAIT around ornamentals in shady, protected areas, at the base of walls and fences, and in 2 to 4 inch wide bands along the edge of walkways and patios. Spread lightly on soil surface around plants. Do not exceed ¼ pound per 250 sq. ft. For best results be sure that area to be treated is damp.

For use on lawns: Mow lawn, remove clippings and thoroughly water. Apply GRASSHOPPER & EARWIG BAIT at the rate of 2 to 4 oz. per 250 sq. ft. [¼ to ½ pound per 500 sq. ft.][½ to 1 pound per 1000 sq. ft.]. Water in immediately after application.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store this product in its original container and keep out of reach of children and domestic animals. PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or

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outdoor drain. CONTAINER DISPOSAL: If empty: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.
