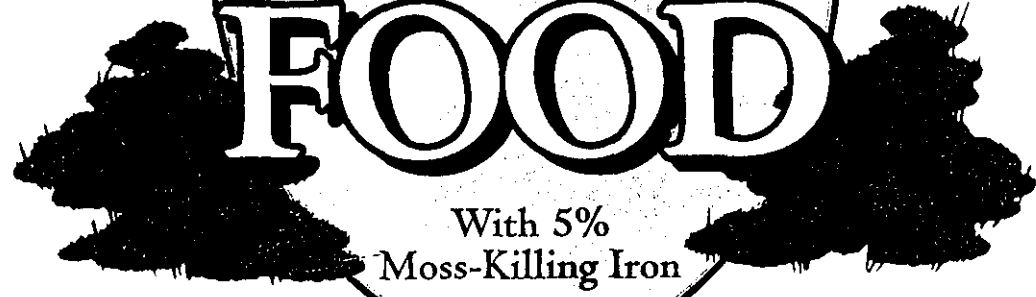

Start lawn after application to start the greening process.

Divide your lawn into easy-to-measure areas. Fill your spreader with the amount of fertilizer needed to cover the area and walk back and forth across the area until the spreader hopper is empty. For example, to cover a 1,000-square-foot area, measure an area 50 feet long by 20 feet wide and fill your spreader with 6 2/3 lbs. (1/3th bag) of *Super Rich Moss Control Lawn Food*.
