Go-West Slug Killer controls slugs and snails in the lawn and garden. Begin applications as early as February and continue with treatments as needed into the fall.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in manner inconsistent with its labeling.

HOW TO USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

(Directions for hose-end sprayer without shut-off; 24 fl. oz. container)

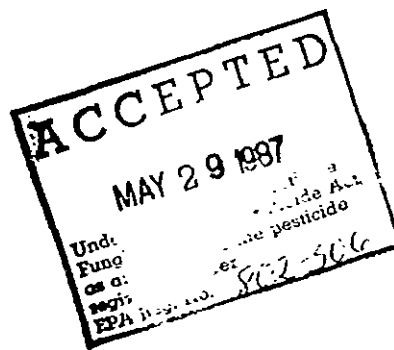
1. Connect spray nozzle to garden hose.
2. Remove bottle cap and screw bottle onto nozzle. Turn on water.
3. Place finger over the hole on the right side of nozzle to begin application. Remove finger from hole to stop application.
4. Spray directly over area requiring application evenly and uniformly. Check handy measuring guide to see how much of this liquid has been used.

(Directions for hose-end sprayer with shut-off; 24 fl. oz. container)

1. Connect spray nozzle to garden hose. Be sure that valve is in "off" position.
2. Remove cap and screw bottle onto nozzle. Turn on water.
3. Turn valve to "on" position to start flow of water. Use valve to shut off flow of water at any time.
4. Spray directly over area requiring application evenly and uniformly. Check handy measuring guide to see how much of this liquid has been used.

SPRINKLING CAN

Mix 1 ounce (2 tablespoons) GO-WEST SLUG KILLER per gallon of water.  
Apply to 100 sq. ft.



#### HOSE-END SPRAYER

Use 1 ounce (2 tablespoons) GO-WEST SLUG KILLER for each gallon of water delivered by your sprayer. Apply one gallon of this mixture to 100 sq. ft.

For complete control, cover entire area. GO-WEST SLUG KILLER should be applied in the evening because slugs feed mostly at night. Re-apply after two weeks or after heavy rain. DO NOT USE ON VEGETABLE GARDENS.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store this product in its original container. Do not reuse container or hose-end attachment. Rinse thoroughly and discard in trash.

#### PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

##### HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Keep out of reach of children. May be fatal if swallowed or inhaled. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Do not allow the product or diluted mixture to contact the edible portion of any food or feed crop. Wash thoroughly after using.

#### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. ANTIDOTE: Artificial respiration: Keep chest and lower extremities warm. Digitalis hypodermically; 10 gr. calcium glucomate intravenously.
