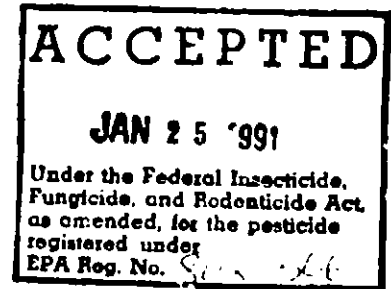

HOW TO USE: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

1. Connect spray nozzle to garden hose. Be sure valve is in "off" position.
2. Remove cap and screw bottle onto nozzle. Turn on water.
3. Turn valve to "on" position to start flow of water. Use valve to shut off flow of water at any time.
4. Spray directly over area requiring application evenly and uniformly. Check handy measuring guide to see how much of this liquid has been used.

SPRINKLING CAN

Mix 3 ounces (6 tablespoons) 60 WEST SLUG FILLER per gallon of water. Apply to 125 sq. ft. (an area approximately 12 feet by 10 feet).

HOSE-END SPRAYER

Use 3 ounces (6 tablespoons) 60 WEST SLUG FILLER for each gallon of water delivered by your sprayer. Apply one gallon of this mixture to 125 sq. ft. (an area approximately 12 feet by 10 feet).

For complete control, cover entire area. 60 WEST SLUG FILLER should be applied in the evening as slugs feed mostly at night. Reapply after two weeks or after heavy rain. DO NOT USE ON VEGETABLE GARDENS.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store this product in its original container. Do not reuse container or hose-end attachment. Rinse thoroughly. Do not discard in trash.
