1. Under the "Environmental Hazards" statement...a) replace "Do not apply directly to water" with "For terrestrial uses, do not apply directly to water, to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark".


2. Use the following format for the "Statement of Practical Treatment":

3. The statement "Contains petroleum distillates" should be moved futher away from the ingredients statement on the label.

USE ONLY WHERE NO PLANT GROWTH IS DESIRED.

Prevents plant growth for up to one year. NOXALL VEGETATION KILLER is a nonselective product intended for use after dilution with water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Version A)

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For household use only.

READ ALL DIRECTIONS AND CAUTIONS BEFORE USE. SHAKE WELL BEFORE USE. Apply this product only as specified on this label. DO NOT USE IN GARDENS, FLOWER BEDS, LAWNS, SHRUBS AND TREES.

Mix one pint per 2 1/2 gallons of water in sprayer or sprinkling can. If sprayer is used, work at lowest possible pressure and use large nozzle opening to give large droplets. Apply this spray mixture per 50 sq. ft. of area. Full wetting of weeds is essential for good control.

Apply to bare ground or when vegetation growth is starting. Vegetation taller than 4 - 6 inches should be cut down. A second application may be necessary to control deep-rooted perennial weeds.

When sprinkling can or sprayer is empty, triple rinse and pour rinses on area just treated. Mix only the quantity needed and use immediately. Do not store leftover solution. To minimize lateral movement, sprinkle area lightly with a watering can immediately after application.

NOTE: Do not apply over roots of desirable plants, in cultivated areas or on ground that is to be cultivated, in greenhouses or near drip line of trees or shrubs. Do not use on slopes or in areas where runoff is likely to occur. Make application when air is calm to minimize drift to adjacent areas.

Do not use a weed killer sprayer to apply insecticides or fungicides.

Keep children and animals off treated areas until these areas dry.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE (Version B)

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For household use only.

What is this product? And what will it do?

Use Lilly/Miller Noxall Vegetation Killer in places where you don't want anything to grow; such as driveways, gravel parking areas, walkways and paths, along fences, around buildings, and under decks. It kills weeds and grass and keeps them from coming back for up to one year.

How do I use this product?

When to use: Spring and fall are the best times to apply this product; but it can be used any time of year as long as the soil is moist down several inches. Soil moisture is the key to good weed control.

What to do: Be sure the soil is moist down several inches. If possible, remove growing weeds and apply Noxall Vegetation Killer to bare soil. If this is not possible, mow weeds to less than two inches high.

Use only in a sprinkling can or tank sprayer. Don't try to cover more area with a gallon of mixed spray than the chart shows. If you are going to get good, long-term control of the weeds, the correct amount of Noxall Vegetation Killer is important. Go over the 20 square feet, until the whole gallon is gone.

Gently water the treated area after application, do not flood. In places with compacted soil, water may not easily penetrate. If water begins to puddle on the surface, stop sprinkling and wait until water has gone into the ground.

Do not allow children or pets into the treated area until product has been watered in and the surface has dried.

What not to do: Do not use this product if you will want anything to grow in the area for up to one year. Do not apply on a windy day or otherwise allow spray to drift onto lawns, vegetable gardens, flowers, shrubs or trees. They will be damaged. Do not use this product in areas where shrub or tree roots may be located or within 12 inches of a lawn. Do not use on slopes. Do not use in a greenhouse.

Mixing and Measuring - Shake Well Before Using

BEST AVAILABLE COPY

It's a good idea to have a separate container just for weed killers, to avoid mix-ups. Use only in a sprinkling can or tank sprayer. Use a spray pattern which gives small droplets, without a fine mist. Over-pumping the sprayer will make a fine mist.

Fill container half full with water before adding Noxall Vegetation Killer, to prevent excess foaming.

What will I see?

If you use Lilly/Miller Noxall Vegetation Killer on bare soil you will not see anything. No weeds or grass will come up for up to one year.

If Lilly/Miller Noxall Vegetation Killer is used on a weedy area, the weeds and grass will begin to turn yellow after a few days. They will turn brown and die over the next few weeks.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children and pets. Do not reuse container. Securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

WARNING: Causes eye irritation. Do not get in eyes. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Harmful if swallowed, inhaled, or absorbed through the skin. Do not contaminate food or feed.

PRRACTICAL TREATMENT:

In case of eye contact, wash with water for at least 15 minutes and seek medical attention. In case of skin contact, wash with plenty of soap and water. Get medical attention if eye or skin irritation persists. If ingested, do not induce vomiting. Drink milk, egg whites, or gelatin; if not available, drink plenty of water. If inhaled, remove victim to fresh air.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN:

There is no specific antidote; if ingested, do not induce emesis and take care to avoid aspiration of stomach contents during gastric lavage. Give a saline laxative and supportive therapy.
