Before Application

- 1. Remove existing weeds.
- 2. Thoroughly work and smooth the area to be treated.
- 3. Carefully measure area to be treated and determine the number of square feet.
- 4. If area to be treated is large, it should be divided into smaller sections and each treated individually.

Application and Rate

1. Shake CASORON GRANULES uniformly on the soil at the rates specified.

FOR ANNUAL WEEDS: Apply in early spring before weeds emerge or after removing weeds.

FOR PERENNIAL WEEDS: For best control, apply after a killing frost from late fall to early winter.

2. ORNAMENTAL WOODY SHRUBS:

Use at rate of 3/4 ounce (2 level tablespoons) for each 10 sq. ft. to be treated. 10 pounds treats 2,133 sq. ft.

FRUIT TREES, NUTS, BLUEBERRIES, GRAPES: Apply 2-3 level tablespoons per 10 sq. ft. Use the higher rate - 3 tablespoons per 10 sq. ft. if weed infestation is heavy or if most weeds are perennial. Wait 30 days after making application before harvesting stone fruits or nuts.

BLACKBERRIES, RASPBERRIES Use 2 level tablespoons per 10 sq. ft. Use only on established plantings. Apply before new shoots emerge in spring.

- 3. Use the diagram below as a guide for uniform distribution of granules. DIAGRAM
- 4. Rates higher than those indicated may cause injury.

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- 5. More accurate and uniform application can be obtained by applying one-half of the required material over the entire treatment area and repeating the application with the remaining material.
- 6. CASORON GRANULES should not be used on sloping areas, because runoff may result in injury to lawn or other plants in adjacent areas.

After Application

- 1. Unless the soil is wet, sprinkle lightly to moisten the soil 1/4 to 1/2 inch deep. Do not flood, avoid puddling and washing.
- 2. Avoid disturbing soil in the treated area as long as weed control is being maintained.

NOTE: Use only on the plants listed. Do not apply to transplant or cutting beds or to newly set transplants, and do not seed or transplant into treated areas for one year after application. Do not use on extremely light sandy soils. Do not plant rotational crops, on which Dichlobenil is not registered, in treated soil within one (1) year after application.

REFILLING INSTRUCTIONS (For smaller canister):

- 1. Be sure that the top applicator ring is in the closed position
- 2. Set the canister upside down on a firm surface.
- 3. Remove bottom "plug" with a coin or screwdriver.
- 4. Carefully refill canister with Lilly/Miller Casoron Granules.
- 5. Press "plug" firmly back into position.
- 6. Return the canister to the upright position.

Prevents Plant Growth For Up To One Year. Treats Up To 725 Sq. Ft. For Nonselective Weed Control.

This product may be used in many places around your yard where you do not want anything to grow; such as driveways, gravel parking areas, walkways and paths, along fences, around buildings, and under decks.

FOR NONSELECTIVE WEED CONTROL - Apply 1-3/8 to 2-1/4 pounds per 100 square feet. The lighter rate may be used if the weed infestation is primarily annuals. For perennial weeds and in dry soil areas the higher rate should be used. Dead weeds from previous seasons' growth do not need to be removed and soil should not be cultivated prior to application.

This product should be applied from late fall through early spring. Applications in the Northeast and upper Midwest should be made in early spring after the ground has thawed. Do not apply to frozen ground or over the top of snow. Do not apply if air temperatures are expected to rise above 70 degrees F within

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the following week. In areas of limited rainfall apply just prior to or during rainy season. For prompt and effective results, rainfall or other precipitation should occur within a few days of application. Do not seed or transplant into treated area for 24 months.

USE PRECAUTIONS: This product is nonselective in action and may destroy all types of vegetation. The treated area may be totally or partially non-productive for one or more years. Apply only to areas where complete plant control is desired. Do not apply to areas on slope above lawns or susceptible crops as runoff water from treated area could cause injury.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store this product in its original container and keep in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not reuse container, except as directed for refilling. Securely wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
