Before Application

- 1. Remove existing weeds.
- 2. Thoroughly work and smooth the area to be treated.
- 3. Carefully measure area to be treated and determine the number of square feet.
- 4. If area to be treated is large, it should be divided into smaller sections and each treated individually.

Application Timing

For annual weeds: Apply in early spring before weeds emerge or after removing weeds. For perennial weeds: For best control, apply after a killing frost from late fall to early winter.

Application and Rate

Shake CASORON GRANULES uniformly on the soil at the rates specified. Rates higher than those indicated may cause injury.

ORNAMENTAL WOODY SHRUBS: Use at rate of 3/4 ounce (2 level tablespoons) for each 10 sq. ft. to be treated. 10 pounds treats 2,133 sq. ft.

FRUIT TREES, NUTS, BLUEBERRIES, GRAPES: Apply 2-3 level tablespoons por 10 sq. ft. Use the higher rate - 3 tablespoons per 10 sq. ft. if weed infestation is heavy or if most weeds are perennial. Wait 30 days after making application before harvesting cherries or nuts.
