WHACK DUST is a ready-for-use insecticide dust which has given effective knockdown and residual control of the pests listed.

WHACK DUST is for residual pest control in and on buildings and structures and their immediate surroundings and on modes of transport. Permitted areas of use include, but are not limited to: stores; warehouses; industrial buildings; houses; apartment buildings; schools; nursing homes; hospitals; restaurants; hotels; food manufacturing, processing and servicing establishments; and on vessels, rail cars, aircraft, buses, trucks and trailers.

Apply WHACK DUST with hand duster, with a paint brush or by other suitable means, to hiding and runway areas and those places where pests are found. Apply lightly and uniformly to infested areas. Pay particular attention to: cracks and crevices; wall voids; around electrical fittings; around water pipes; under and behind cabinets, refrigerators and sinks; around window and door frames; along baseboards; and in attics and crawl spaces. The amount to be applied will vary with the site but should usually be in the range of 2-4 teaspoons per square yard. Repeat treatments as necessary to maintain adequate control.

10 oz. directions:

Cockroaches (including both non-resistant and organophosphate and organochlorine resistant strains), Ants, Crickets, Silverfish and Firebrats: Apply thoroughly to all areas where these pests crawl and hide, especially in cracks and crevices and hidden surfaces around sinks and storage areas, behind baseboards, around doors and windows, behind and under refrigerators, cabinets, sinks and stoves and in attics and crawl spaces. For ants, apply to ant trails, around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises.

Carpenter Ants: Apply around doors and windows and other places where ants enter premises and where they crawl and hide. Also force dust into infested wood through existing openings or newly drilled small holes. When possible locate and treat nests and surrounding areas.

Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas (Indoors): Apply dust to infested areas such as pet beds and resting quarters, nearby cracks and crevices, under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, between and under cushions of upholstered furniture and other areas where these pests may be present. Old bedding of pets should be removed and replaced with clean fresh bedding after treatment of pet areas. Do not treat animals or their bedding with this product. Treat pets with an EPA approved product registered for direct application to pets.

Spiders: Apply along and behind baseboards, to window and door frames, corners, pipes, storage localities, attics, crawl space and other areas over which these pests may crawl.

Wasps and Bees: It is generally advisable to treat wasp and bee nests in the evening when insects are less active and have returned to the nest. Wear protective clothing if deemed necessary to avoid stings. Using hand or power duster or other suitable means, with extension tubes if necessary, thoroughly dust nest and entrance and surrounding areas where insects alight. Nests in wall voids can be the area, blow dust in, and reseal. For ground wasps, dust entrance and surrounding areas. For best results check nests carefully one or two days after treatment to ensure complete kill, then remove and destroy nest to prevent emergence of newly-hatched insects. If removal is not feasible, retreat the nest, if necessary. Do not use this product to treat overhead nests.

Sowbugs, Pillbugs, Ground Beetles, Earwigs, Millipedes, Centipedes and Scorpions: Apply around doors and windows and other places where these pests may enter premises. Treat baseboards, storage areas and other locations where these pests are found.

ORNAMENTAL PESTS

Whack Dust is a ready-for-use insecticide dust which gives effective knock-down and residual control of specified pests on non-edible flowers, shrubs and trees.

NOTE: Whack Dust has demonstrated excellent plant safety, however, all species and varieties have not been tested. When treating large numbers of plants of a single variety, treat a few plants and observe prior to full scale application.

CAUTION: This product is highly toxic to bees exposed to direct treatment or to residues on plants.

USE DIRECTIONS (For 10 oz. squeeze duster)

1. Shake container to mix air with dust.
2. Lift plastic cap, then pointing the opening toward the plants, gently squeeze plastic tube to insure uniform, light dust application.
3. Close cap after each use.

FOR BEST RESULTS

1. Lightly apply dust to underside as well as top of all plants. Treat when pests first appear.
2. Repeat applications as necessary.
3. If rain occurs within 24 hours after application of dust, repeat treatment.

Black vine weevil and obscure root weevil (adults) control:

Begin treatment for the adult weevil in May or June or as soon as weevil is present. Treat every two weeks or more often for severe infestation.

Residual Treatment (Outdoors): To help prevent infestation by ants, brown dog ticks, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, earwigs, firebrats, fleas, ground beetles, millipedes, pill bugs, silverfish, sowbugs, spiders, wasp. Make a residual treatment around windows and doors, porches, screens, eaves, patios, garages, under stairways and in crawl spaces and other areas where pests hide.

To help prevent invasion of buildings and structures by above pests, treat a band of soil and vegetation 6 to 10 feet wide around and adjacent to the building or structure. Also treat the building foundation and crawl spaces where pests are active and may find entrance. Apply thoroughly and uniformly to the band area. Pay particular attention to ant hills and wasp nests in the band area.

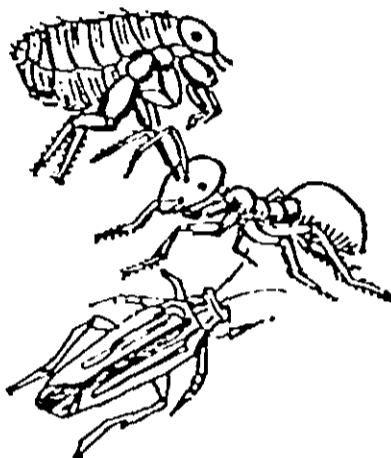

Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas in Buildings: Apply to floors, bed rooms, chair pet beds and bedding quarters, in cracks and crevices, under the edges of rugs and floor coverings, between and under baseboards of walls, and in areas where ticks and fleas are likely to hide.
