IF SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious, do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting.

- 2. Under the "Precautionary Statements" revise this section to read as follows:

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

DANGER: Corrosive, causes eye damage. Wear protective eyewear when handling. Do not get in eyes, on skin or clothing. May be harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing dust. Wash thoroughly after handling and before eating or smoking.

FIRST AID

If In Eyes: Flush with plenty of running water. Get medical attention. If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. If irritation persists get medical attention. In Inhaled: Remove affected person to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. If Swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Induce vomiting by giving 1 or 2 glasses of water and touching back of throat with finger. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. For household use only. Not for use indoors.

For best results, apply THIS PRODUCT at the normal rate when the lawn is dry. Mow lawn to expose existing moss prior to application. This allows the pellets to fall through the grass to the soil and go to work. Water in to hasten the greening process.

For established lawns, apply at the rate of 20 lbs. per 4,000 square feet. This full feeding controls moss in the lawn, leaving it rich, green and thriving.

Lawns must be thoroughly watered the day before application. Begin spreading by laying down two strips of THIS PRODUCT at each end of lawn. Fill in remaining area as shown here. Close the spreader when you stop walking or make turns to avoid uneven coverage. Stopping and starting with the spreader box open will waste lawn food. Overlap previous wheel track slightly, as shown, to avoid gaps in coverage. Water in after application to start the greening process.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store this product in its original container and keep in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not reuse bag. Securely wrap bag in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.

Moss threatens to take over lawns during the warm, rainy periods in spring and fall, but it will grow all year round in shady areas. THIS PRODUCT kills the moss quickly and completely with 10% iron. We carefully blend THIS PRODUCT to give your lawn all the nitrogen university experts say it needs. Some of the nitrogen goes to work right away and some works slowly over time. Your lawn looks great and you won't have to feed it again for another 2 months. The best defense against moss, weed and disease attack is a thick, vigorous lawn. Promoting the overall vigor of your lawn will help fight against moss, weeds and diseases. THIS PRODUCT contains the three essential nutrients for your lawn:

- * Nitrogen (N) to stimulate thick, rich, green growth
- * Phosphorus (P) for early root formation
- * Potash (K) helps build resistance to disease

OR

(For formula with no fertilizer claim): Lawn moss is a common problem in many areas. Moss thrives in damp, shady lawns, where the soil is acidic and drainage is poor. Under these conditions moss can spread into areas where grass once grew. If steps are not taken, moss can "take over" a lawn. Fortunately, moss can be quickly killed with applications of THIS PRODUCT. Killing the moss give grasses a chance to "reclaim" the lawn. Since grass may be slow to fill in bare spots, we suggest reseeding bare spots with a quality grass seed such as Lilly/Miller Grass Back. THIS PRODUCT has another benefit - turning grass a deep green, the color most of us want for our lawns. THIS PRODUCT has 10% Iron to kill lawn moss and green the grass. Because no fertilizer is added you get the moss control and the greening without the excessive growth that requires frequent mowing. One pound of THIS PRODUCT is equal to approximately 1 1/2 cups.

OR

Moss invades the weak spots in your lawn caused by thinning and excess thatch build up. Controlling moss and fertilizing will make your lawn vigorous and strong, and less susceptible to further moss invasion. THIS PRODUCT is a special combination of plant foods formulated to control moss and promote strong, vigorous, lush green turf. A few days after you have applied THIS PRODUCT, the moss will die and turn black. If the moss is thick, gently rake out the dead moss. The fertilizer will already be working to help your lawn grow into the empty spaces.
