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PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

ANGER
CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. ~~Causes eye and skin irritation.~~ Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

Add Category I eye statements
If swallowed: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. If in eyes: Flush with plenty of water and seek medical attention. *for 15 minutes*
NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: Irrigate eyes with 0.05M disodium edetate (EDTA) solution. If on skin: Immediately remove contaminated clothing and flush skin with plenty of water. If inhaled: Flush nostrils with water and seek medical attention.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For best results, apply Ready-To-Use Moss-Kil just prior to the time when fall rains begin or in early spring.

Moss growth can occur in nearly any location where dampness persists. Such areas include decks, steps, patios and fences. Because moisture is essential, most moss growth appears during the fall; some occurs in the winter and spring. Very little moss forms in summertime.

Controlling moss may add months or years, of service to decks, fences, steps and such areas, and can keep walkways and steps from becoming slippery and dangerous.

Destroying existing moss is done most effectively during times when its growth is most rapid and when rain is not expected for several days.

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SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

READ ENTIRE LABEL. USE ONLY AS DIRECTED. OBSERVE ALL CAUTIONS AND PRECAUTIONS.

HOW TO USE ON WOOD AND CONCRETE:
DECKS, STEPS, PATIOS, SIDEWALKS, FENCE POSTS

Adjust nozzle to medium or coarse spray. Hold nozzle six to ten inches from surface and spray to thoroughly wet area. Avoid drift and runoff, especially if lawn or any desirable plants are nearby.

For heavy moss, dampen, or spray when moss is damp to avoid runoff and assure thorough coverage. Apply when the air is still and when no rain is expected for 24 hours.

USE PRECAUTIONS

Avoid drift or runoff onto lawns, bedding plants, shrubs or any desirable plants because injury may result. Do not use in lawns or ornamental beds. Do not use on copper gutters, downspouts or fixtures.

Only use this sprayer to apply diluted Lilly/Miller Moss-Kil. Do not use for any other purpose. When contents of container have been used, follow mixing directions on the label of Lilly/Miller Moss-Kil, to refill this sprayer. Shake well before using.
