**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS**

**HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

**DANGER:** Causes irreversible eye damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin, or on clothing. Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash before reuse. **STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT:**

**1 Swallowed:** Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. If possible, vomiting should be induced under medical supervision. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person. **If In Eyes:** Flush with water for 15 minutes and seek medical attention.

**If On Skin:** Immediately remove contaminated clothing and flush skin with plenty of water.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS:**

Do not apply directly to water or wetlands. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE:** It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For best results, apply Ready-To-Use MOSS-KIL just prior to the time when fall rains begin or in early spring. Moss growth can occur in nearly any location where dampness persists. Such areas include decks, steps, patios and fences. Because moisture is

essential, most moss growth appears during the fall; some occurs in the winter and spring. Very little moss forms in summertime. Controlling moss may add months or years of service to decks, fences, steps and such areas, and can keep walkways and steps from becoming slippery and dangerous.

Destroying existing moss is done most effectively during times when its growth is most rapid and when rain is not expected for several days.

**SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING**

**READ ENTIRE LABEL. USE ONLY AS DIRECTED. OBSERVE ALL PRECAUTIONS**

To open nozzle, depress button and rotate nozzle clockwise about 1/4 turn for spray, turn farther for stream.

To close, rotate nozzle counter clockwise until nozzle locks.

**HOW TO USE ON WOOD AND CONCRETE - DECKS, STEPS, PATIOS, SIDEWALKS, FENCE POSTS:** Adjust nozzle to medium or coarse spray. Hold nozzle six to ten inches from surface and spray to thoroughly wet area. Avoid drift and runoff, especially if lawn or any desirable plants are nearby. For heavy moss, dampen, or spray when moss is damp to avoid runoff and assure thorough coverage. Apply when the air is still and when no rain is expected for 24 hours.

**USE PRECAUTIONS:** Avoid drift or runoff onto lawns, bedding plants, shrubs or any desirable plants because injury may result. Do not use in lawns or ornamental beds. Do not use on copper gutters, downspouts or fixtures.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Store this product in its original container and keep in a locked storage area out of reach of children and domestic animals. Do not reuse container. Rinse thoroughly before discarding and securely wrap original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
