Lilly/Miller Ready-To-Use Porch & Patio Spray requires no mixing. It is ready for use on certain vegetables and ornamental flowers and shrubs to control aphids, leafhoppers, whiteflies and other insects listed below.

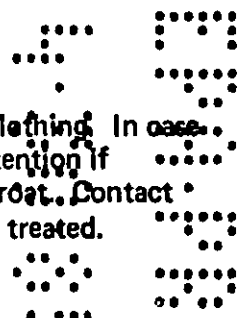
Apply throughout the growing season and repeat sprays as necessary. Vegetables may be harvested on the day of treatment. See below for specific cautions and directions.

For outdoor use including; around the patio, porch and garage:

Shake the container before using and adjust spray nozzle to deliver medium spray droplets. Spray the surfaces of these areas. Spray the insects themselves whenever possible. Repeat spray if necessary.

For Ants: Treat nests and points of entry and trails. Spray the ants when possible.

For Wasps & Hornets: Spray Lilly/Miller Ready-To-Use Porch & Patio Spray during the late evening when these insects are inactive. Protective clothing is recommended. Spray Lilly/Miller Ready-To-Use Porch & Patio Spray generously into breeding and hiding places. Contact as many insects as possible with spray.

For Spiders: Treat webs and spiders with spray.

For Cockroaches, Palmetto bugs, Earwigs, Sowbugs, Centipedes, Millipedes, Crickets, Silverfish and Clovermites: Spray these pests directly whenever possible. Thoroughly treat cracks, crevices, moist areas, openings around pipes - spigots, storage areas and sheds. Make another application if necessary.

For mosquitoes, gnats (midges) houseflies, biting flies, small flying moths (millers).
To rid porch and patio of unwanted pests, spray area using a slow sweeping motion. Spray when air is calm. While spraying move away from area just treated. Vacate area until sprays have settled. Spray vegetation where these insects rest, such as shrubbery and grass - again if necessary.

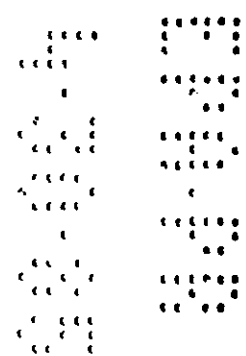
In Vegetable Gardens— Shake container before use and adjust spray nozzle to give medium size spray droplets for vegetables and ornamentals.

Hold sprayer 18 to 24 inches from foliage and spray the lower and upper leaf surfaces and stems. Use a circular motion for even and thorough coverage. Repeat application weekly or as needed for desired control of insects. Use less spray on tender, new, plant growth. Use Lilly/Miller Ready-To-Use Porch & Patio Spray throughout the growing season including day of harvest, on these crops:

On Woody Ornamentals - Shake container before use and adjust spray nozzle to give medium size spray droplets for vegetables and ornamentals.

Hold sprayer 18 to 24 inches from foliage and spray the lower and upper leaf surfaces and stems. Use a circular motion for even and thorough coverage. Repeat application weekly or as needed for desired control of insects. Use less spray on tender, new, plant growth. Use Lilly/Miller Ready-To-Use Porch & Patio Spray on these and other woody ornamentals:

To control gypsy moth caterpillars and adults and tent caterpillars, treat plants as soon as these insects appear. Spray entire plant thoroughly. Apply spray weekly until infestations are controlled.
