To control Ants (including foraging fire ants), Armyworms, Billbugs, Centipedes, Chiggers, Chinch Bugs, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, Fiery Skipper Larvae, Flea Beetles, Fleas, Gnats, Grasshoppers, Greenbugs, June Beetles, Leafhoppers, Lucerne Moth, Millepedes, Mites (Clover, Formula Grass, Winter Grain), Mosquitoes, Sod Webworms (Lawn Moth Larvae), Sowbugs (Pillbugs), Spittlebugs, Springtails, Ticks, and Tropical Grass Webworms.

Apply 1% CHLORBAN INSECT GRANULES at the rate of 2 1/2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. (1/2 lb. per 200 sq. ft.) of area. Use any hand operated gravity spreader designed for application of granular materials. See Spreader Settings.

Treat when insects first appear. Immediately after application, sprinkle the turf with 6 gallons of water per 200 sq. ft. so as to wash the granules into the zone of insect infestation.

WHITE GRUB CONTROL (Larvae of European Chafer and Japanese Beetle) Apply 1% CHLORBAN INSECT GRANULES at the rate of 5-10 lbs. per 1,000 square feet (1-2 lbs. per 200 square feet) of area.

See Spreader Settings. Apply the granules uniformly over the area to be treated, followed immediately by a thorough watering to wash the insecticide into the turf. For best results treat when grubs are young and actively feeding near the soil surface, usually during late July and August. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service for proper time to treat in your area.

EUROPEAN CRANE FLY LARVAE CONTROL (Leather Jackets)

Apply 3 1/2 lbs. 1% CHLORBAN INSECT GRANULES to 1,000 square feet using any hand operated gravity spreader designed for application of granular materials. See Spreader Settings. Immediately after application, sprinkle the turf with 30 gallons of water per 1,000 square feet. For timing of applications you should consult your local Agricultural Extension Service.

HYPERODES (Turfgrass) WEEVIL CONTROL

Apply 1% CHLORBAN INSECT GRANULES at the rate of 5 lbs. per 1,000 equare feet (1 lb. per 200 square feet) of area.

See Spreader Settings. Treat suspected problem areas in mid-April and again in mid-May. Consult your local Agricultural Extension Service Specialist for best time to treat in your area.

SPREADER SETTINGS

To help obtain uniform distribution, apply one-half the required amount of product in one direction, then apply the balance at right angle.

To help prevent infestation of homes and buildings by Ants (including foraging fire ants), Boxelder Bugs, Carpenter Ants, Chiggers, Clover Mites, Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Flies, Millepedes, Mosquitoes, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs (Pillbugs), Spiders, Ticks and Yellowjackets:

Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage, Cauliflower, Rutabagast, Chinese Cabbage, Turnips*: Use 1/2 to 1 pound of product per 100 linear feet of row by placing over the seed in a 2 to 4 inch wide band at time of planting. Sprinkle or irrigate with water after planting.

*With Rutabagas and Turnips, it would be realistic to expect only early

season protection because of their extended growing season.
