Use GRANULAR NOXALL VEGETATION KILLER in places you don't want anything to grow; such as driveways, gravel parking areas, walkways and paths, along fences, around buildings, and under decks. It kills weeds and grass and keeps them from coming back for up to one year.

How do I use this product?

When to use: Spring and fall are the best times to use GRANULAR NOXALL VEGETATION KILLER; but it can be used any time of year as long as the soil is moist down several inches. Soil moisture is the key to good weed control.

What to do: Be sure the soil is moist down several inches. If possible, remove growing weeds and apply this product to bare soil. If this is not possible, mow weeds to less than two inches high.

Scatter the granules evenly over the area. When using a broadcast spreader, do not allow the granules to fly into grass areas or ornamental plantings. They will be damaged.

Gently water the treated area after application, do not flood. In places with compacted soil, water may not easily penetrate. If water begins to puddle on the surface, stop sprinkling and wait until water has gone into the ground. Granules will completely dissolve with additional rain or waterings. Do not allow children or pets into the treated area until granules have dissolved and surface has dried.

What not to do: Do not use this product if you will want anything to grow in the area for about one year. Do not use on slopes. Do not allow granules to get into the lawn, into vegetable gardens, or around flowers, shrubs and trees. They will be damaged. When watering, do not allow water to wash granules into areas with growing plants. Do not use this product in areas where shrub or tree roots may be located.

Measuring and Applying -

On areas of bare soil or with few weeds: Use 1 to 2 cups of GRANULAR NOXALL VEGETATION KILLER per 100 square feet (10'x 10'). Sprinkle the granules evenly over the area. See the illustrations.

On areas with lots of weeds: Use 2 to 4 cups of GRANULAR NOXALL VEGETATION KILLER per 100 square feet (10'x 10'). Sprinkle the granules evenly over the area. See the illustrations.

For hard-to-kill weeds such as thistle, guackgrass, bindweed, Johnsongrass, and other deep-rooted weeds: Use 4 cups to 8 cups of GRANULAR NOXALL VEGETATION KILLER per 100 square feet (10'x 10').
