HOW TO APPLY: Weed & Grass Preventer will not kill existing weeds. Before applying Weed & Grass Preventer, remove any weeds, grass, fallen leaves and other plant debris. Rake area smooth, if necessary. Do not use more than the recommended amount of Weed & Grass Preventer or damage may result. Do not apply to steep areas where runoff is possible. Do not use on dichondra or turfgrasses. Do not plant grass or shallow-rooted flowers and groundcovers (less than 4") in treated areas for 4 months following treatment. To prevent weed growth from occurring, do not disturb surface after treatment. Do not apply to or around vegetables. Respray

treated area every 4 months to keep the area weed free. Do not respray a treated area more than 2 times in one year.

To prevent staining avoid application to fences, sidewalks, patios, cement blocks, stucco or painted surfaces. If these surfaces are accidentally sprayed, hose off with water. May stain clothing.

TANK OR PRESSURE SPRAYER INSTRUCTIONS: Start with a clean sprayer. Fill half full with water, add recommended amount of Weed & Grass Preventer to sprayer, then add remaining water. With top on sprayer, shake for 5 seconds to mix. Spray to cover area uniformly. After application, turn on sprinkler or irrigation system for about 1 hour. Do not allow material to run off treated area.

Apply Weed & Grass Preventer in the fall, 2 to 4 weeks after planting and before weeds come up. Apply again in late winter or early spring to weed-free soil. Do not apply to tulip plants taller than 3/4".

HOSE END SPRAYER INSTRUCTIONS: To apply Weed & Grass Preventer with a Lilly/Miller Big 15 or other hose-end type sprayer with similar capacity; determine the size of the area to be treated, add the amount of Weed & Grass Preventer required for that area to the sprayer jar, fill sprayer jar with water to the correct marking and spray to cover the area uniformly. After application, turn on sprinkler or irrigation system for about 1 hour. Do not allow material to run off treated area.

NON-SELECTIVE COMBINATION SPRAY: Using Weed & Grass Preventer and Round-Up or Round-Up L&G.

This combination will kill existing vegetation and keep weeds and grasses from growing for up to three months. Use for driveways and walkways; along sidewalks, fences and patios; around trees, shrubs and ornamental plantings.

DO NOT SPRAY OVER TOP OF DESIRABLE PLANTS. If spray contacts desirable foliage, wash off immediately with clean water. Do not allow spray mixture to stand overnight in spray tank. This will result in poor weed control.

All information on the individual product labels, including all cautions and precautions, must be followed.

TANK OR PRESSURE SPRAYER INSTRUCTIONS: Start with a clean plastic, fiberglass, aluminum or stainless steel sprayer. Fill half full with water, add recommended amount of Weed & Grass Preventer to sprayer, add recommended amount of Round-Up or Round-Up L&G, then add remaining water. With top on sprayer, shake for 5 seconds to mix.

NOTE: A galvanized or unlined steel sprayer is not recommended; however, if used, any spray solution not applied that day must be emptied and the sprayer rinsed.

Spray to cover the area uniformly. Do not water treated area for at least 24 hours after application. After 24 hours, turn on sprinkler or irrigation system for about 1 hour. Do not allow material to run off treated area.
