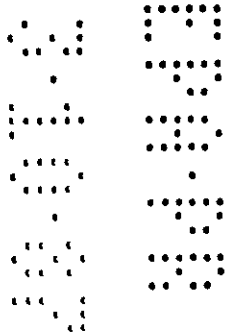

How to apply-

Hose 'n Go Weed & Grass Preventer will not kill existing weeds. Before applying Hose 'n Go Weed & Grass Preventer, remove any weeds, grass, fallen leaves and other plant debris. Rake area smooth, if necessary. Do not disturb surface after treatment. Hose 'n Go Weed & Grass Preventer will cover 1000 sq. ft. of established ornamental beds, gravel walkways, driveways, etc. Check measuring guide on container to assure correct application. Overapplication can cause damage to shrubs, trees and ground covers. Do not apply to steep areas where runoff is possible. Do not use on dichondra or other turfgrasses. Do not plant shrubs, trees, ground covers or grass in treated area for one year following treatment. Do not apply to or around vegetables or annual flowers.

To prevent staining, avoid application to fences, sidewalks, patios, cement blocks, stucco or painted surfaces. If these surfaces are accidentally sprayed, hose off with water. May stain clothing.

SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING

[Directions for hose-end sprayer without shut-off]

1. Connect spray nozzle to garden hose. 2. Remove bottle cap and screw bottle onto nozzle. Turn on water. 3. Place finger over the hole on the right side of nozzle to begin application. Remove finger from hole to stop application. 4. Spray directly over area requiring application evenly and uniformly. (Check handy measuring guide on back container label to see how much of this liquid has been used.) 5. After application, turn on sprinkler or irrigation system for about 1 hour. Do not allow material to run off treated area.

[Directions for hose-end sprayer with shut-off]

1. Connect spray nozzle to garden hose. Be sure that valve is in "off" position. 2. Remove bottle cap and screw bottle onto nozzle. Turn on water. 3. Turn valve to "on" position to start flow of water. Use valve to shut off flow of water at any time. 4. Spray directly over area requiring application evenly and uniformly. (Check handy measuring guide on back container label to see how much of this liquid has been



used.) 5. After application, turn on sprinkler or irrigation system for about 1 hour. Do not allow material to run off treated area.
